# Temps soar above 30 degrees in Bhopal, many other dists

**Bhopal:** Anticipate a shift in weather patterns over the next three days in the Gwalior-Chambal region of Madhya Pradesh, signaling the arrival of spring. Rainfall is expected on February 21 and 22, with a possibility of hail on one of those days. Meanwhile, other regions of the state, including Bhopal, Indore, and Ujjain, are forecast to remain clear.

Preceding this weather shift, temperatures soared above 30 degrees Celsius on Monday in 36 cities, including Bhopal, Indore,

Gwalior, Ujjain, and Jabalpur.
On the same day, Damoh,
Tikamgarh, and Khajuraho experienced temperatures exceeding 34 degrees Celsius for the first time this February, with Khajuraho reaching the highest at 34.4 degrees Celsius. Pachmarhi recorded the lowest temperature at 27.8 degrees Celsius.

Bhopal witnessed a maximum temperature of 33 degrees Celsius for two consecutive days, while In-

### Now, Gwalior-Agra Greenfield Expressway will be built in one package

#### NHAI's estimated cost increased by Rs 1343 crores

Chronicle Reporter, Gwalior The proposed 88.40 km long six-lane expressway from Gwalior to Agra will now be constructed in a single package instead of three. Earlier, NHAI had fixed its estimated cost at around Rs 2500 crore.

Three packages were fixed to prepare it on hybrid annuity mode, but due to lack of interest from the companies, tenders have been made to give the contract of 88.40 km directly in a single package. It will be prepared on Build Operate and Transfer i.e. BOT basis. In such a situation, the cost of the project has also increased. Now NHAI has issued a tender worth Rs 3841 crore for this, which will be opened on 23rd February.



In the earlier tender issued by NHAI, the first package of 36.800 km between Agra to Dholpur was fixed at Rs 972.10 crore. Similarly, the second package of 14.40 km from 36.800 to 51.200 km was fixed for Rs 1012.38 crore and the third package of 37.200 km length was fixed for Rs 997.41 crore. For this, three separate tenders were issued in December 2023. In Ham mode, NHAI was to

#### Will be able to reach Agra in one hour After the completion

of this expressway, the distance to Agra will be reduced by 33 km. Agra can be reached in just one hour, while the journey to Noida can be com-

pleted in just three hours. The length of the present Gwalior-Agra Highway is about 121 km and it is four lanes. This highway passes through the populated areas of Morena and Dholpur, due to which traffic jams persist and the speed limit of vehicles also remains low. It takes two to two and a half hours to reach Agra from Gwalior. The construction of the new six lane Greenfield Express will be started from Agra side. This expressway will be connected to the Outer Ring Road under construction in Agra.

It will pass through 14 villages of Agra, 18 of Dholpur and 30 villages of Morena and will end at village Susera from Gwalior. The distance between the existing highway and expressway will be eight km.
