

Ujjain gears up for Simhastha 2028

Ujjain: In a landmark initiative to prepare Ujjain for the Simhastha Mahakumbh in 2028, Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav today laid the foundation stone for development projects totaling Rs 864 crore. The ambitious plan includes constructing 29 km of new ghats along both banks of the Shipra River, stretching from Shani Temple to Nagda Bypass, at a cost of Rs 779 crore. Additionally, 21 new barrages, costing Rs 85 crore, will be built on the Shipra. These extensive developments aim to facilitate bathing for an estimated 5 crore devotees within 24 hours during the Simhastha festival.

Cultural resonance and Ahilyabai's legacy

Speaking at the ceremony at Angareshwar Mahadev Temple, CM Yadav hailed the event as a "Dharma Sabha," emphasizing the revered presence of saints. He highlighted that the project aligns with the ongoing celebration of Devi Ahilyabai Holkar's 300th birth anniversary, recognizing her legacy of blending development with cultural preservation. "Today's India is moving forward, embracing both development and heritage," he stated. Dr. Yadav underscored

Ensuring pure Shipra waters and enhanced connectivity

A key focus of the project is ensuring the purity of the Shipra River. Dr. Yadav detailed plans to divert polluted water from the Gambhir River dam downstream for filtration before it reaches the Shipra.

Furthermore, the Silarkheri project will collect rainwater, which will then be released into the Shipra after the monsoon, guaranteeing clean water throughout the year. Beyond the ghats, plans include operating boats for pilgrims along various stretches of the river.

CM Yadav also outlined broader infrastructure upgrades, including a metro train service from Indore to Ujjain and the construction of elevated roads, all part of a meticulous

managed development strategy. He expressed confidence that Simhastha 2028 would be an unparalleled success.

Local leaders and saints applaud vision

Local leaders, including MP Anil Firojiya and Water Resources Minister Tulsiram Silawat, praised the continuous development under CM Yadav, highlighting central government support for projects like the four-laning of the Ratlam-Nagda railway line, which will ease pilgrim travel. Mahant Shri Hari Maharaj of the All India Akhara Parishad blessed the initiative, acknowledging that the expansion of ghats addresses a long-standing need for devotee convenience.

Ceremonial beginnings and cultural Showcase

The ceremony commenced with CM Yadav performing worship at Angareshwar Mahadev, followed by captivating cultural performances. The event, attended by numerous dignitaries and spiritual leaders, concluded with tributes to Maa Saraswati and Devi Ahilyabai, reaffirming Ujjain's commitment to a grand and spiritually enriching Simhastha Mahakumbh.

Why is POK not a part of India even after Operation Sindoor?

Congress MP Jeetu Patwari says lack of political will is the reason

Bhopal: In a bold statement during the Congress' Jai Hind Sabha, Madhya Pradesh Congress President Jitu Patwari questioned why Pakistan-Occupied Kashmir (PoK) has not yet been integrated into India, despite the much-publicized Operation Sindoor. He attributed this to a lack of political will, not military strength. "Our armed forces are unmatched in courage and capability. The failure lies in the political leadership's resolve, not the army's potential," Patwari said. He accused the government of using the military's valor for optics while lacking the intent to act decisively on national issues.

Taking aim at Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Patwari remarked, "The Prime Minister is the crown of the nation, but when he bows to foreign pressure—especially from the U.S.—it's a matter of national shame."

He also criticized the External Affairs Minister for allegedly stating that

Pakistan was warned before India's military actions. "That's an insult to the armed forces. If ministers continue to undermine our army, they should be removed or publicly condemned," he added, slamming the

BJP for "sharing platforms with those who disrespect the forces." On rising crimes against women in Madhya Pradesh, Patwari asked, "What about the 'Sindoor' of the 25 sisters raped across the state? Why is the Prime Minister silent on the atrocities against tribal women in Khandwa and Balaghat?"

Concluding his address, he praised Rahul Gandhi, calling him "a true people's leader" for championing caste-based census and constitutional rights.

Congress veteran Digvijay Singh notably joined the event by sitting among party workers instead of on the stage, signaling solidarity with the grassroots.
