

Open loot in the name of tax and price hikes - Mukesh Nayak

► Congress accuses Madhya Pradesh Govt. of crushing citizens with tax blitz

Bhopal: A political firestorm has ignited in Madhya Pradesh as the Congress party, led by Mukesh Nayak, vehemently condemns the government's newly implemented tax hikes, branding them a "daylight robbery" against the state's struggling populace. The crux of the Congress's outrage stems from the stark disparity between the government's pre-budget promises of no new taxes and the sudden imposition of increased financial burdens.

Nayak, President of the MP Congress Media Department, accuses the government of "exploitation, deceit, and oppression," highlighting the immediate impact of hiked property guideline rates, a 3.46% electricity charge surge, and increased levies on essential services. He argues that these measures, far from providing relief, are designed to "loot the citizens and fill its coffers."

The increased property guideline rates, he claims, render land ownership an unattainable dream for the poor and middle class, effectively nullifying the



government's promised housing subsidies. He paints a picture of a calculated effort to trap the vulnerable in poverty. Dismissing the government's "minor" la-

bel for the electricity hike, Nayak emphasizes the crushing burden it places on impoverished families.

He further argues that the cumulative effect of increased toll taxes, water bills, and other levies signals an "anti-people agenda," exacerbating the existing woes of inflation, unemployment, and farmer debt. Nayak questions the destination of the increased revenue, pointing to the persistent issues of dilapidated infrastructure and inadequate public services, implying potential misuse for political gain.

"False promises, the facade of development, and false hopes of relief—is this nothing short of a betrayal," Nayak asserts, challenging the government's audacity in deceiving the public. He demands immediate reversal of the "exploitative" policies and warns of impending public protests if the government fails to provide relief. "The people are watching, and their patience is wearing thin," he concludes, signaling a potential escalation of political tension.

Employees stationed at the Financial Management Information System (FMIS) and the State Hospitality Officer's office in the Secretariat will also receive allowances equivalent to those of their counterparts in the Ministry.

Transport Allowance Revised to Rs 384 per Month

Previously, government employees received only Rs 200 per month for transport allowance under the Sixth Pay Commission, but this has now been increased to Rs 384. For differently-abled employees, the monthly transport allowance has been raised from Rs 350 to Rs 675.

Ready-to-stay shelter will be constructed along Narmada Parikrama Path

Bhopal: A departmental meeting was organized on Narmada Parikrama Path as well as other subjects in the Ministry on Tuesday under the chairmanship of Panchayat and Rural Development, Labor Minister Shri Prahlad Singh Patel. In the meeting, Minister Shri Patel discussed in detail with the officials on the construction of Ready to Stay Shelter keeping in mind the Narmada Parikrama. He said that the shelter can be constructed in about one and a half acres, in which along with planting trees, good arrangements for staying can also be ensured. Minister Shri Patel also instructed the officials to make special arrangements for those doing Chaturmas. He said that people or committees who take initiative themselves for help can be included in this.

Begging continues on streets despite government ban

► Beggars persist at traffic Signals and temples in Bhopal

Bhopal: Despite the government's imposition of a ban on begging, beggars are still actively present at almost every traffic signal and temple across the city. This persistent issue is raising questions about the effectiveness of the administration's efforts and is also causing growing concern over the law and order situation in the capital.

The government had imposed a ban on both begging and offering alms, with strict actions promised for anyone found violating the law. However, beggars, including children, women, the elderly, and even young adults, continue to be seen begging, especially at busy traffic signals like Board Office and Roshanpura, as well as outside temples. This not only poses a risk to the beggars but also creates potential danger for other motorists.




While the government has made provisions for employment, shelter, and food for beggars, these efforts seem to be largely ignored. It is essential for the authorities to monitor such areas more closely to ensure these individuals do not resort to begging. Moreover, legal action should be taken against those who are forcing children to beg at public places, particularly near temples and on roadsides, to put an end to this practice once and for all.

NHDC Recorded Second Highest Power Generation since inception

NHDC has successfully generated 5575.02 Million Units of electricity against the generation target of 4900 Million Units under Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) set for Excellent Rating during FY 2024-25, which is 24.63% higher than generation of FY 2023-24. Patanjali eyes broader Madhya Pradesh investment beyond manufacturing

Bhopal: Patanjali Yogpeeth, having committed to establishing an industrial unit in Ghurehta, Mauganj district, is now exploring significant investments in Madhya Pradesh's burgeoning IT and agriculture sectors.
