

State leads in Waqf property digitization



Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh is emerging as a national model in the digitization of Waqf properties. The Minority Welfare Department, in coordination with the Revenue Department, has completed the digitization of all 15,003 Waqf properties in the state. The first-level verification has been

done by the Waqf Board, while second-level verification is underway by the Revenue Department, which has so far verified 2,425 properties.

In 11 key districts—Ujjain, Vidisha, Bhopal, Shajapur, Sehore, Raisen, Indore, Dhar, Burhanpur, Dewas, and Mandasaur—all Waqf properties have been digitized. These include 1,054 properties in Ujjain, 929 in Vidisha, and 816 in Bhopal.

Simultaneously, work is progressing on all seven projects under the Pradhan Mantri Jan-Vikas Karyakram, focused on education, health, and skill development in minority-dominated areas. Notable progress includes 90% completion of a 100-seater girls' hostel in Mhow, 85% of a Sadbhavna Mandap in Khargone, and 80% of eight Anganwadis in Sheopur. Additionally, over one-third of the Rs 316.96 crore upgrade to Gandhi Medical College and Hamidia Hospital in Bhopal is complete.

Give top priority to promotion work: CS



Bhopal: Chief Secretary Anurag Jain has directed all department heads to give top priority to promotion-related work under the Madhya Pradesh Public Service Promotion Rules-2025. He instructed that the process of promoting officers and employees should be completed by July 31,

2025, emphasizing that employee welfare must remain a key focus in alignment with the state government's vision.

Speaking at a meeting held at the Mantralaya on Thursday, Jain noted that the new rules resolve a long-standing issue that has remained pending for nine years.

The framework was developed after extensive consultations by the Senior Secretaries' Committee and the General Administration Department, and its implementation is expected to enhance administrative efficiency.

Additional Chief Secretary (GAD) Sanjay Dubey and Deputy Secretary Ajay Katesaria gave a detailed presentation on various aspects of the new rules. Topics covered included reservation calculation, DPC procedures, eligibility, ACR evaluations, pay fixation, sealed cover procedures, and vacancy filling.

The Chief Secretary also responded to department-specific queries from officials of Police, WCD, Urban Administration, and others. The meeting was attended by the DGP Kailash Makwana, senior bureaucrats, and heads of departments from multiple ministries.

Efforts intensified to ensure inclusive voting for Divyang voters

Bhopal: Chief Electoral Officer of Madhya Pradesh, Sukhveer Singh, chaired a meeting of the State Steering Committee on Accessible Elections at Nirvachan Sadan, Bhopal, on Thursday. The discussion focused on including left-out Divyang voters in the electoral roll. Mr. Singh also shared initiatives of the Election Commission of India (ECI) aimed at facilitating a more accessible voting process for Divyang voters during Assembly and Lok Sabha elections.

He highlighted that polling stations have been equipped with ramps, wheelchairs, signage in large fonts, token systems, drinking water, accessible toilets, and comfortable seating. The "PWD App" allows Di-

vyang voters to register and update their disability status, while the Voter Helpline App and NVSP Portal offer further assistance. Braille voter ID cards and ballot papers have been introduced for visually impaired voters.

To sensitize personnel, training is being provided to polling staff, police, and NGOs.

Voters with over 40% disability who are unable to visit polling stations will be allowed to vote through Form 12-D (postal ballot). The ECI has also launched the "Saksham App" for on-ground assistance at polling centers.

The meeting saw participation from election officials, department representatives, NGOs, and educational institutions.

Indian Army to conduct major flood relief and rescue drill in Bhopal today

Bhopal: The Indian Army's Western Madhya Pradesh Sub Area, through its 3 EME Training Centre located in Khanuagaon, will conduct a comprehensive flood relief and search-and-rescue exercise (drill) and equipment exhibition at Bada Talab (Upper Lake) tomorrow, June 27th, starting at 10:45 AM.

Protests rock Ministry Gates

Bhopal: The Mohan government's newly introduced promotion rules for Madhya Pradesh government employees and officers are facing intense backlash, escalating into a major protest outside the Ministry's main gates on Thursday. General category employees vehemently demonstrated against the Promotion Rules 2025, specifically opposing reservations for ST/SC categories in promotions.

“Not against reservation, but against unlawful practices”

Sudhir Nayak, President of the Ministry Services Officers-Employees Association, clarified their stance: “We are not against reservation, but providing opportunities to the reserved category on unreserved posts is against the law.” He argued that this would lead to reserved category individuals occupying unreserved positions, a situation previously seen under the 2002 promotion rules.

SAPAKS plans further action

Meanwhile, SAPAKS (Samanya Pichhra



Alpsankhyak Kalyan Samaj) is also gearing up for a broader agitation. They have called a crucial meeting on June 29th, inviting all employee and officer organizations to strategize. Employees are determined to oppose the new rules at the district level, demanding that Madhya Pradesh adopt promotion policies similar to those in Uttar Pradesh. Their core argument: “When the country is one, why

should the rules be different?” Concerns are particularly high given the current occupancy of reserved posts within the Ministry: of 65 Under Secretary positions, 58 are held by reserved category officers; all 14 Deputy Secretary posts are occupied by reserved category officers; and all three Additional Secretary positions are similarly filled by reserved category officers.

self-reliant, provides better opportunities, and aids social development by helping them acquire essential life skills.” He concluded by stressing education's crucial role in the progress of society and the nation. The inauguration ceremony was well-attended by Rajesh Dixit, Janpad President, District and Janpad Panchayat members, local public representatives, officials, staff, and enthusiastic school students.
