

Congress presents suggestions to Election Commission for upcoming elections

Bhopal: In a meeting convened by the Election Commission at its office in Bhopal, Congress presented a set of suggestions for the upcoming Assembly and Lok Sabha elections. The meeting included representatives from all recognized national political parties.

J.P. Dhanopia, the Congress party's election commission coordinator, presented the party's viewpoint under the guidance of Pradesh Congress President Jitu Patwari.

Dhanopia suggested a return to paper ballots for elections, addressing the ongoing confusion and doubts surrounding EVM machines. He recommended that even in by-elections, paper ballots should be

used instead of EVMs. Additionally, he proposed extending the time for the VVPAT slip from 7 to 10 seconds to ensure voter satisfaction, and suggested that VVPAT slips be counted after the EVM votes to verify the results before announcing the election outcome.

Other suggestions included conducting mock polls on election day at least 2-3 times, ensuring that Form 17C is filled and made available to election agents, and establishing permanent BLO (Booth Level Officer) offices in every constituency for ongoing voter list corrections. Dhanopia also raised concerns about the presence of dupli-

cates names in the voter list and suggested the use of software to regularly detect and remove duplicates.

To prevent electoral fraud, he proposed linking voter ID cards with Aadhaar numbers and using thumb impressions during voting. He also called for a ban on anganwadi workers from election duties, citing their potential to influence voters in favor of political parties. Further, he requested that complaints regarding violations of the model code of conduct be promptly addressed by establishing a dedicated cell in the Election Commission for immediate action.

Confusion and uncertainty for professors as re-deployment deadline passes

Bhopal: The re-deployment of 616 professors to various Prime Minister Colleges of Excellence (PMCOEs) and autonomous colleges across the state was initially set for a two-month period. However, it has been over a month since the deadline expired, and the state government has yet to provide any clarity on their future status. The professors, who were sent on re-deployment, are now in a state of confusion, unsure whether they should continue at their current postings or return to their original colleges.

When the PMCOEs were established, around 400 professors were sent on re-deployment. Their tenure has now ended, and over 1,000 professors are left in limbo. They are uncertain whether they will be sent back to their original

positions or will remain at the PMCOEs. Despite the expiration of the re-deployment period, the government has not issued any instructions regarding their future.

The professors who were initially sent for two months have now been waiting for over three months without any official communication from the government. They are growing increasingly anxious, as the government has neither allowed their return nor given them the option to stay at the PMCOEs. Although the government is reportedly preparing a transfer policy, which may provide clarity on their future postings, no decision has been made yet. Meanwhile, the professors are left in a state of uncertainty, unsure of their next steps.

Bhopal: UG Exams at BU to begin from April 1

Strict measures to prevent cheating

Bhopal: The practical exams at Barkatullah University (BU) in the capital began on March 13, and now, the theoretical exams for undergraduate first and third-year students will start on April 1. A total of 1,80,000 students are expected to participate in these exams, and preparations are in full swing. To ensure fairness, the university has implemented strict measures to curb cheating. BU officials have stated that any student caught cheating may have their entire exam annulled.

PG semester exams in May

The theoretical exams for first-year BA, BSc, BCom, BSc (Home Science), BA Management, BBA, BCA, and VPE students, as well as third-

year students, will commence on April 1. Meanwhile, postgraduate semester exams will take place in May. The university has already begun preparations for these exams as well.

Stringent security measures at exam centers

BU has instructed all college principals and exam center heads to conduct thorough checks of all students entering the exam centers. Prohibited items like books, guides, mobile phones, handwritten materials, smart watches, and electronic devices must be deposited outside. If a student leaves the exam hall within the first 30 minutes, they will be given a new answer sheet. Any

student found cheating or carrying banned devices will have their answer sheet confiscated, and the exam will be canceled.

Flying Squads to monitor exam centers

To further ensure the integrity of the exams, flying squads will be deployed at various centers, and a control room will be set up to monitor the situation.

Additionally, the number of exam centers will be reduced to allow for tighter supervision. Centers with fewer than 50 or 60 students will be shut down to enhance security and vigilance during the exams.

New flights connecting Bhopal to more cities in the pipeline

Bhopal: The Raja Bhoj Airport in the state capital is set to see an expansion in air connectivity, with plans underway to introduce new flights connecting Bhopal to several other cities. This initiative is part of an ongoing effort to enhance travel options and reduce travel time for passengers.

The focus is on linking Bhopal with smaller and mid-sized cities directly, with cities like Nagpur, Gondia, Rewa, and Jabalpur being prioritized for air connectivity. The Aviation Department has streamlined this process by removing the 600 km distance restriction under the UDAN scheme, allowing airlines to offer routes even between airports more than 600 km apart.

This change is expected to benefit

travelers significantly by providing new routes and enhancing convenience. Launched in April 2017, the UDAN scheme initially saw SpiceJet operating direct flights from Bhopal to destinations like Shirdi, Nashik, and several others. However, these services were discontinued later, leading to inconvenience for many passengers.
