

MP to hire 2,000 specialist doctors

Deputy CM Shukla announces at health drive



Bhopal: Deputy Chief Minister Rajendra Shukla announced a major drive to recruit 2,000 specialist doctors to strengthen health-care across Madhya Pradesh, particularly in

centres lacking expert medical staff. The announcement was made while inaugurating the 'Swasth Nari – Sashakt Parivar Abhiyan' (Healthy Woman – Empowered Family Campaign) health camp at the Community Health Center in Bilkisganj, Sehore district.

The campaign, launched as part of the 'Se-wa Pakhwada' (Service Fortnight) marking Prime Minister Narendra Modi's birthday, focuses on ensuring quality health and nutrition for women and adolescent girls. Mr. Shukla inspected the camp, which included a blood donation drive, and distributed nutrition baskets to TB patients under the TB Mukh Bharat Abhiyan. He emphasized the government's commitment to expanding healthcare under the leadership of the Prime Minister and Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav. The campaign provides screening and treatment for serious illnesses like hypertension, diabetes, and various cancers. Mr. Shukla also stressed promoting telemedicine to connect citizens directly with specialists, reducing the need for travel.

Patwari accuses BJP of betrayal over farmers and women's schemes

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh Congress president Jeetu Patwari launched a sharp attack on the BJP government while addressing a massive gathering during the Navratri 'Chunari Yatra' at Tokkhurd village in Dewas district. The event was attended by former minister Sajjan Singh Verma, former district Congress president Manoj Rajani, rural district president Manish Chaudhary, party workers, and thousands of villagers. Patwari alleged that the BJP had deceived both farmers and women voters. He reminded the audience that farmers were promised Rs 6,000 for soybean and Rs 2,700 for wheat, but the benefits were yet to reach them. Similarly, he



said the "Ladli Behna" scheme had promised women Rs 3,000 per month, but only Rs 1,250 was being provided, accusing the government of "stealing" the remaining Rs 1,800.

Challenging Chief Minister Mohan Yadav, Patwari demanded immediate payment of the full Rs 3,000 to beneficiaries. He warned that failure

to do so could even threaten the BJP leader's position.

Patwari urged people to recognise what he described as the government's "false promises" and assured that Congress would continue fighting for the rights of farmers, women, and the common citizen.

Cross-District Engineers to inspect MP road repairs, ensuring quality

Public Works Department issues orders

Bhopal: In a major move to ensure the quality of post-monsoon road maintenance, the Public Works Department (PWD) has implemented a new system requiring engineers from one district to inspect and verify the patch repair work (patch repair) done in another. This arrangement is designed to eliminate conflicts of interest and guarantee no compromise on quality.

The heavy monsoon this year severely damaged roads across Madhya Pradesh. With the rains subsiding, the PWD is launching a massive campaign to

repair potholes and damaged sections on highways and city roads.

New rules for quality control: On Thursday, the PWD issued orders formalizing the new inspection protocol. To ensure accountability, verifying engineers must also upload video and photographic evidence of the repaired sections to the department's official portal, providing transparent proof of work completion.

Furthermore, the PWD has mandated training for all stakeholders:

***Training & Monitoring:** All Chief Engineers (CEs) must conduct online

video-conferences to train Executive Engineers, Assistant Engineers, Sub Engineers, and contractors involved in maintenance and performance guarantee roads.

***On-Site Demonstration:** Executive Engineers are now required to provide a physical demonstration of the patch repair process in the presence of contractors, ensuring adherence to MORT&H and IRC guidelines and proper standardized procedures.

The PWD is making it clear that patch repair will not be a mere formality of "sticking asphalt layers," but a high-quality job strictly monitored by CEs.

Applications open by Oct 30 for one-year practical astrology diploma

Bhopal: Maharishi Patanjali Sanskrit Sansthan, operated under the School Education Department, is launching a one-year practical astrology (Jyotish) and practical Vastu Shastra diploma course. The application process for the diploma began on September 25th through MP Online. Applications can be submitted until October 30, 2025. The minimum educational qualification required is to pass Class 12 from the Board of Secondary Education or a recognized board.

Classes will begin online on November 1, 2025. Astrology classes will be conducted online three days a week, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, and practical Vastu Shastra classes will be conducted three days a week, Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. The online classes will be conducted at the Sanskrit Bhavan located at Second Stop, Bhopal, Maharishi Patanjali Sanskrit Sansthan. The curriculum guidelines have been finalized.

Strict action against buses without first aid boxes

Bhopal: The Transport Department has intensified a state-wide vehicle inspection campaign, launched on September 22, focusing on ensuring all passenger buses carry first aid boxes. This move follows directives from Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav, emphasizing passenger safety.

On Thursday, the department inspected 1,718 passenger buses at various locations and issued challans to those lacking first aid boxes. Authorities clarified that buses without first aid kits will not be granted new permits.

In a parallel action, Transport Commissioner Vivek Sharma ordered inspections of Automated Testing Stations (ATS). At Manali Industries ATS in Jabalpur, several violations were found, including the issuance of fitness certificates to vehicles lacking High-Security Registration Plates (HSRP) and retroreflective tape. The staff also lacked proper training. A show-cause notice has been issued to the facility.


