

Mass wedding ceremonies held in capital and across state

Opposition unity blocks women's reservation: Cong

By Special Correspondent Bhopal: The Congress on Monday termed the defeat of the Women's Reservation Amendment Bill in Parliament as a "victory for democracy and the Constitution", asserting that a united Opposition had thwarted what it described as the Centre's attempt to consolidate power through delimitation.

According to party leaders, the voting on the amendment exposed public rejection of "divisive politics". Of the 528 votes cast, 298 were in favour while 230 opposed the Bill, resulting in its failure to pass. The Congress maintained that while it fully supports women's reservation, it opposes linking the provision



to census and delimitation exercises.

Reiterating its longstanding commitment, the party noted that it had backed the Nari Shakti Vandana Adhiniyam in September 2023 and has historically championed women's political empowerment—from proposing 33 per

approach was aimed at delaying implementation and manipulating electoral arithmetic. It demanded immediate enforcement of reservation within the existing 543 Lok Sabha seats, a sub-quota for OBC women, and the decoupling of reservation from census and delimitation processes. Calling the issue a broader struggle for rights and representation, the party said women across the country are no longer willing to wait. It urged the government to move beyond "rhetoric" and demonstrate genuine commitment through decisive action.

NSUI stages protest over remarks against their leader



By Special Correspondent Bhopal: The National Students' Union of India (NSUI) on Monday staged a strong protest in Bhopal against alleged derogatory remarks made by Door-darshan anchor Ashok Srivastava against Leader of the Opposition Rahul Gandhi, as well as the arrest of NSUI activists in Delhi over the issue.

The demonstration was held outside the Pradesh Congress Committee office and led by State NSUI president Ashutosh Chouksey. Agitated workers raised slogans and burnt an effigy of the Prime Minister to register their protest.

Addressing the gathering, Chouksey described the incident as a direct attack on democratic values. He alleged that offensive remarks against a senior opposition leader Rahul Gandhi, coupled with the arrest of protesting students, reflected an attempt by the government to suppress dissent.

He asserted that the NSUI would continue its struggle against injustice and defend democracy, freedom of expression, and students' rights. A large number of party workers participated in the protest.
