### Maratha quota: Jarange targets Pawar

Says OBC leaders betrayed own community

Maratha reservation activist Manoj Jarange Patil has launched a sharp

attack on Sharad Pawar, chief of the Nationalist Congress Party (Sharadchandra Pawar faction), alleging that Pawar had in 1994 diverted the Maratha community's rightful 16% reservation to the Other Backward Classes (OBC), depriving Marathas of their due rights.

This marks the first time Jarange has openly accused Pawar. "We will own efforts. But the fact is we should have received it back in 1994. Sharad Pawar gave our rightful share to the OBCs. Yet the OBC community has not acknowledged his favour." Jarange said. He also accused OBC



leaders of harming their own community's interests.

Jarange claimed that Minister Chhagan Bhujbal and Congress Legislature Party leader Vijay Wadettiwar held a secret meeting to plan leadership for the OBC reservation protection movement.

## HC to hear plea both supporting and opposing Maratha reservation from today

The Bombay High Court today said it will begin hearing, from tomorrow, a batch of petitions filed both in support of and against the Maharashtra government's ordinance granting Marathas reservation under the Other Backward Classes (OBC) category.

The Government Resolution (GR), issued on September 2 regarding Maratha reservation implementing the Hyderabad Gazetteer, ĥas reignited a long-standing and emotionally charged debate over caste-based quotas in the state. The court will hear a significant plea moved by Mangesh Sasane, chairman of the OBC Welfare Foundation, questioning five GRs issued since 2004 that permitted Marathas to seek Kunbi certificates.

### ED attaches properties worth over Rs 40 Cr in Mysuru MUDA Scam



New Delhi (UNI)

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has attached 34 immovable properties, including Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) sites with a market value of Rs. 40.08 crore, in connection with the MUDA scam case, an official said today.

The ED initiated its investigation based on a First Information Report (FIR) registered by the Lokayuktha Police in Mysuru concerning a largescale scam in the allotment of sites The probe revealed the routing and layering of undue gratification obtained by GT Dinesh Kumar, the former Commissioner of MUDA, the official said.

These proceeds of crime were used to purchase immovable properties in the names of Kumar's relatives and associates. The investigation further uncovered the illegal allot-ment of 31 MUDA sites by GT Dinesh

These searches revealed that the sites were allotted in gross violation of the Karnataka Urban Development Authorities (Allotment of Sites instead of Compensation for Land Acquired) Rules, 2009 — as amended in 2015 — and the Karnataka Urban Development Authority (Incentive Scheme for Voluntary Surrender of Land) Rules, 1991.

## SC rejects V. Senthil Balaji's plea

The Supreme Court today refused to entertain a plea filed by former Tamil Nadu Minister and DMK leader V. Senthil Balaji, who sought clarification on an earlier order that had compelled him to resign as minister in April this year.

A Bench comprising Justice Surya Kant and Justice Joymalya Bagchi heard the application and observed that the April 28 order, passed by a Bench led by Justice Abhay S. Oka

#### Leh Apex Body says 'normalcy in Ladakh is fake'

Leh/Srinagar: Leh Apex Body (LAB) co-chairman Chering Dorjay today claimed that the situation in Ladakh is far from normal and urged the government to immediately lift restrictions and release those detained to restore public confidence.

Leh Apex Body and Kargil Democratic Alliance(KDA) have been spearheading an agitation for the last four years for statehood restora tion and constitutional safeguards for Ladakh. Both groups withdrew from the talks with the Centre following last week's violence that left four dead and over 100 injured.

Dorjay said that despite the claim of calm, the reality on the ground tells a different story.

"People who are looking at the surface think everything is normal here, but it is completely fake. The internet is still shut down, there are restrictions on people, and question ing of locals continues," he told reporters in Leh.

### Govt set to revise Jan Aushadhi Kendra norms

Much to the relief of Jan Aushadhi Kendra operators in the retail sector, the government has assured them of revoking its earlier zero-distance policy revising to 500 meters for setting up new centres under the Prime Minister Narender Modi's ambitious Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) aimed at providing quality medicines at afford-

At a press conference here, representatives of the PMBJK Retailers Asthe Department of Pharmaceuticals (DoP), under the union Chemicals and Fertilisers Ministry, today at a meeting assured them of revoking the zero-distance policy.

Instead of zero distance, a minimum distance of 500 metres will now be mandated between two Kendras, said Prashant K Singh, president of the PMBJK Retailers Association. He, said a formal notification on the revised distance norm is expected

Currently, about 19,000 Jan Aushadhi Kendras operate nationwide, offering nearly 2,047 medicines and 300 surgical items at affordable prices. Singh said the DoP has said that they will implement it soon as consent has also to be taken from the union Health Ministry as



Pinning hopes on the government's assurance on the distance issue, the Association also raised concerns over other operational chal-

Suresh Mittal, General Secretary of the Association, pointed out that the recent GST rate reduction has created financial difficulties for retailers. Stock purchased earlier at higher tax rates now has to be sold at reduced MRP via point-of-sale systems, resulting in a direct loss of approximately 7% GST for retailers registered under the Composition scheme and causing severe working

### Karnataka CM loses temper, snaps at minister; dismisses 'November kranti'

Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah lost his temper during a media interaction herê today, snapping at his own minister, Shivaraj Tangadagi, over a question regarding a separate Lingayat religion.

The incident occurred at Ginigera Air Strip in Koppal when journalists asked the Chief Minister about the ongoing caste census and the demand for Lingayats to be recognised as a separate religion. Tangadagi struggled to clarify the

miscommunication, after which Siddaramaiah snapped at him, stating he had no official stance on the Lingayat separate religion issue, adding, "Some virakta seers are demanding it." He emphasised that people could choose their religion freely.

The Chief Minister also expressed irritation when reporters asked about halting government guarantees for months. He responded, "We have not stopped them. If you have specific complaints, come to me and we will rectify them." When asked about a possible "November Kranti", or change of guard, Siddaramaiah dismissed the notion, stating, "There will be no kranti as such.

Earlier, Siddaramaiah sparked controversy after he appeared to almost slap an Additional Superintendent of Police (ASP) during a public event in Belagavi. The incident, captured on video, shows Siddaramaiah raising his hand in anger after summoning ASP Narayan Bharamani onto the stage to question his handling of disruptions near the venue.
