

Religious respect remains, but 'Babar' structure must go: Uma

Bhopal: Veteran BJP leader and former Chief Minister Uma Bharti has escalated the national discourse on historic religious sites, issuing a sharp statement that has ignited fresh political controversy.

In a strong message released on her social media handle on Tuesday, Bharti affirmed her respect for places of worship built in the name of God and Islam, but drew a clear line regarding structures named after the Mughal emperor Babur.

"The building named after Babur will meet the same fate that the one in Ayodhya met on December 6," she declared, referencing the 1992



demolition. "Even the bricks were missing then."

Bharti also issued direct advice to West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, urging her to take action against those advocating for the construction of a mosque in

Babur's name. She stated, "It is your responsibility to maintain the dignity and harmony of Bengal and the nation."

The statement has split political opinion: BJP supporters view it as defending "historical and cultural identity," while opposition parties condemn it as "provocative and tension-raising." Experts are urging restraint from all sides, emphasizing the need for responsible dialogue amid rising debates over religious claims and historical sites. The West Bengal government has not yet officially responded to the provocative comments.

SIR: 57.05% of enumeration forms digitized in MP

Bhopal: The digitization of enumeration forms in the state is 57.05% complete. Enumeration forms have been distributed by BLOs to over 57.3 million voters. Following the instructions of the Election Commission of India, SIR work is underway to ensure accurate and error-free voter lists in the state.

Under this initiative, BLOs are distributing and digitizing counting sheets to voters. As of November 23, 65,014 booth-level officers have provided counting sheets to 57.3 million voters in the state. Of these digitization of

327,48,305 counting sheets has been completed, representing 57.05% of the total

Enumeration forms to be filled by Dec 4

During the special intensive revision of the voter list, BLOs are going door-to-door to distribute counting sheets to voters. This process will continue until December 4th.

Voters can also fill out the enumeration forms online during the SIR. To do this, voters must visit the Election Commission of India's website at voters.eci.gov.in and fill out

the form. Voters can also easily access the 2003 voter list by visiting the Chief Electoral Officer of Madhya Pradesh's website at <https://ceoelection.mp.gov.in>

To ensure the timely completion of the enumeration form digitization process, each BLO has been assigned a team of two to three members to assist them. These include government servants with extensive knowledge of the area and its residents—such as Patwaris, Panchayat Secretaries, Village Employment Assistants, etc. A separate team of computer opera-

tors has also been deployed to digitize the counting sheets. Help desks have been estab-

Education is panacea for Muslims, fanaticism harms

Bhopal: Former administrative officer and prominent author Niaz Khan has stirred controversy on social media with a bold statement addressing the role of education within the Muslim community. Khan asserted that "Education is the panacea (Ram-Baan Aushadhi) for Muslims, understand this."

Modern education verses extremism

Khan's polarizing post directly contrasted the outcomes of modern education with rigid beliefs. He wrote: "The Muslim who attained modern education became a Mayor in London and New York, and a Governor and Lieutenant Governor. But the one who took the path of persistence remained a mechanic, a perpetrator



of injustice against women, and a
puncture repairman."

Social media erupts in debate

The statement has triggered a fierce debate on X (formerly Twitter). Supporters view Khan's comments as necessary self-reflection and a positive push for modern education. However, critics labeled the remarks as over-generalization and discriminatory, arguing that denigrating any profession is inappropriate. Political commentators suggested that while a focus on reform is necessary, such sensitive topics must be addressed with greater care to avoid social tension. Khan has yet to respond, but his post remains a central

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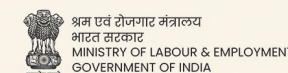
