

Bhopal celebrates patriotism with ‘Har Ghar Tiranga’ bike rally

Bhopal: A bike rally was held in Bhopal on Wednesday under the ‘Har Ghar Tiranga’ campaign. During this, bikers gave the message of patriotism. They participated in the rally wearing traditional costumes and safa. Super bikes also participated in the rally.

About 100 super bike riders, members of Bhopal biking community and women bikers became part of the rally. The rally started with flag off from Kushabhau Thackeray Convention Center (Minto Hall). During this, an atmosphere of patriotism was created by releasing tricolor balloons in the sky. The rally passed through the major tourist places and historical places of Bhopal.

CM to lead state-level Independence Day celebrations

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh is gearing up for a series of patriotic and vibrant events to mark the anniversary of Independence Day. The main state-level function will be held at Bhopal's Lal Parade Ground, where Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav will hoist the national flag, inspect the parade, and deliver a message to the citizens of the state.

A day of homage and celebration

The day's proceedings will begin with a solemn tribute as Chief Minister Dr. Yadav honors martyrs at the Shaurya Smarak. At 9:00 AM,

ceremonies will begin at district headquarters, where the Assembly Speaker, various ministers, and collectors will hoist the flag and take the salute of the parade. The Chief Minister's address will be broadcast live from the main state event between 9:25 AM and 9:55 AM, reaching all district-level functions.

Decentralized festivities

To ensure widespread participation, the celebrations will extend to all levels of local governance. Flag hoisting will be conducted by Janpad Panchayat presidents at their headquarters and by mayors and village heads in their respective

areas. All government offices and educational institutions will hold flag-hoisting ceremonies before 8:00 AM, followed by a host of cultural and literary programs, sports competitions, and debates.

Honoring heroes and illuminating landmarks

In a heartfelt gesture, the state will honor freedom fighters, families of Kargil martyrs, and other democracy activists. Elderly freedom fighters will receive personal felicitation from district officials at their homes. Adding to the festive atmosphere, key public buildings and monuments across Madhya Pradesh will be beautifully illuminated on the nights of August 14 and 15, creating a spectacular display of national pride.

Independence Day flag-hoisting districts swapped for four ministers

Bhopal: Just one day after the initial assignments, the districts where four ministers were slated to hoist the national flag for Independence Day have been changed. The adjustments were made following requests from the ministers, who were initially assigned to districts far from their home constituencies. Urban Development and Housing Minister Kailash Vijayvargiya, who was originally assigned to the distant Satna district, will now lead the celebrations in Dhar. Vijayvargiya, who hails from Indore, reportedly made an official request to be assigned to a closer district.

Similarly, Minister of Farmer Welfare and Agriculture Development Edal Singh Kansana was moved from Chhatarpur to Datia at his request. Energy Minister Pradyuman Singh Tomar, originally assigned to Pandhurna—a significant distance from his home district of Gwalior—has now been reassigned to Shivpuri.

In a related change, Minister of State Radha Singh's assignment was switched from Maihar to Singrauli. The changes aim to accommodate the ministers while ensuring the Independence Day ceremonies proceed smoothly across the state.

Chlorine gas leak in Govindpura causes panic and breathing issues

Bhopal: On Wednesday afternoon, a chlorine gas leak at a factory in Bhopal's Govindpura Industrial Area resulted in eye irritation and breathing difficulties for nearby residents. The incident occurred around 3:30 PM at a facility on JK Road, where chlorine gas began leaking from the chemical storage area, causing alarm among locals.

Upon receiving reports of the leak, Govindpura Sub-Divisional Magistrate Ravish Kumar Srivastava promptly arrived at the scene. He was joined by personnel from the State Disaster Emergency Response Force (SDERF), the Municipal Corporation's fire brigade, police, and electricity company staff. The gas leak was identified as emanating from outside the factory, and caustic

soda was utilized to neutralize the chlorine gas. This containment process was completed within an hour.

Residents in the vicinity experienced tearing eyes and respiratory issues due to the gas exposure. SDM Srivastava and

other staff put on masks for protection.

Gas spread due to water spray

Reports indicate that the chlorine gas spread further when water was sprayed by fire brigade trucks to mitigate the situation, as water caused the gas to disperse.

In response to the incident, Collector Kaushlendra Vikram Singh has mandated a thorough investigation, with a report expected within two days. He has requested a joint inquiry involving the Chief Medical and Health Officer, Municipal Corporation, and the Industry Department. SDM Srivastava stated that strict action would be taken against any parties found responsible in the investigation.

Electricity Board offers discounts to settle power theft cases at Lok Adalat

Bhopal: In a major relief for consumers, the MP Central Zone Electricity Distribution Company has announced a special settlement scheme for power theft and irregularity cases during the National Lok Adalat on Sept 13. The initiative aims to resolve pending legal matters amicably and swiftly. The Lok Adalat, which will cover 16 districts across the Bhopal, Narwadapuram, Gwalior, and Chambal divisions, offers significant discounts to eligible consumers. For pending cases under Section 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003, domestic, agricultural, and small-scale commercial users can receive a 30% discount on the assessed civil liability and a full 100% waiver on interest.
