To stem 'money & muscle power', DU to revamp student union poll process

DELHI UNIVERSITY has proposed to overhaul its students' union election process for a poll free of "money and muscle power". The suggestion was presented at the varsity's Executive Council meeting Thursday.

The administration took note of the Delhi High Court order issued on November 11, 2024, in Prashant Manchanda vs. Union of India, where the court proposed a structural shift from the current single-tier election to a

two-tier model. The proposal, according to the court, is designed "to prevent defacement and the use of muscle and money power at the university level"

Last year, the Delhi High Court stayed the counting of votes for the Delhi University

Students' Union (DUSU) polls till public property defaced by candidates during campaigning was cleaned up. It had summoned 15 candidates and directed them to give an undertaking that "they shall not deface or mutilate any public property" in the future. It is learnt that the committee formed (who formed the

committee?) following the HC's

orders suggested replacing the existing election system with a two-tier model that decentralises the voting process. The proposed system allows colleges,

departments, and centres to conduct their own elections, with elected representatives advancing to the university level to determine the DUSU office bearers.

"The committee merely presented its suggestions in the EC meeting today as a reporting item. It is not part of the agenda. The suggestions are being shown to stakeholders to get their suggestions on how to conduct the elections to ensure they are free from money and muscle

power. This structure that is being proposed is how elections used to be conducted in the 1990s, too," a senior official at DU told The Indian Express.

"The procedure suggested is that the colleges, its societies, and the departments will have their own elections, and the ones who win internally will have a chance to get a spot on the DUSU panel. This is being proposed to make the election free and fair and to ensure safety on the campus during campaigning," the official added.

The court, in its order last year, noted that the change from a single to a two-tier election

aligns with a key recommendation from the Lyngdoh Committee. It also instructed DU to monitor compliance with the new election guidelines and ensure that students who have previously defaced public property

fulfill their commitment to a bunch of pleas pertaining to restoring it. In response, the university's Narendra Modi's degree from council had resolved that the DUSU advisor and chief election

officer must submit a detailed proposal outlining the implementation of the new election model. The Vice-Chancellor had been authorised to "take appropriate decisions and report the same to the Executive Council".

YEIDA hands over 230 acres for Film City coming up in Jewar

THE YAMUNA Expressway Development Industrial Authority (YEIDA) Thursday handed over 230 acres designated for the development of the International Film City near the upcoming Noida International Airport at Jewar to Bayview Bhutani Film City Private Limited, also known as Bayview Projects LLP - a special purpose vehicle led by producer Boney Kapoor and construction giant Bhutani Infrastructure.

"Today is a big day. The Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister's dream to establish an international film city around Yamuna Expressway is going to come true," said YEIDA Chief Executive Officer Dr Arun Vir Singh

The Film City is set to come up in YEIDA's Sector 21, along the Yamuna Expressway and around 4 km from the international airport. The contract to build the Film City was formally issued last June to Bayview Projects LLP.

As per the master plan, in the first phase of the project, 230 acres will be developed - while 75 acres will be dedicated to commercial development, the rest will cater to the film industry. The project, estimated to cost Rs 1,510 crore, is expected to be completed within eight years.

"Initially, the size of the plot to be handed over was 1,000 acres. After consultation with stakeholders, we decided to provide 230 acres of land for devel-

> opment under Phase 1 of the project," Singh said. UP Industrial Development Minister Nand Gopal Gupta 'Nandi' said the upcoming Film City will create 5 lakh to 7 lakh iobs in the state. "The Film Citv is set to be a significant driver of UP's industrial growth. We anticipate it will create 5-7 lakh jobs, both directly and indirectly. The Film City's success could pave the way for similar initiatives across various sectors in the state, as the UP government remains committed to fostering industrial development and achieving our goal of a 1 trillion dollar economy at the ear-

liest." he told The Indian Express.

In all, the HC is hearing six petitions, which includes four filed by DU, challenging the December 2016 order of the CIC.

Among the four petitions filed by DU, one also challenges a CIC order of December 2016, whereby it had directed the university to recover Rs 25.000 from the salary payable to the Central Public Information Officer in five equal monthly instalments for rejecting an RTI application, as the fee for the same was not paid.

The DU's pleas have been filed against the various RTI applicants – Neeraj Kumar, Mohd Irsad, R K Jain, and others.

The fifth petition has been filed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) against one Mohd Nashadudin and others, where the Board has challenged a January 2017 order of the CIC to facilitate inspection of records and provide certified copies of the documents selected free of cost, except personal details in admit card and marksheet. Nashadudin had sought copies of the admit card and marksheet of Modi in an RTI applica-

tion moved in 2015. The sixth petition has been filed by Delhi-based lawyer Mohd Irsad, challenging the reiection of his RTI application seeking information about Modi's degree.

The application was rejected on the ground of non-payment of the RTI fee to the authority concerned at the appropriate time.

Customs officials seize gold concealed inside dates at Delhi airport

New Delhi: Customs officials seized gold concealed inside dates from a man at the Indira Gandhi International Airport in Delhi. The Customs department said that based on spot profiling, a 56-year-old Indian passenger was intercepted upon his arrival from the Saudi Arabian city of Jeddah on Wednesday.

"Further examination of the baggage led to the recovery of assorted yellow metal cut pieces and a chain, all believed to be gold, totaling 172.00 grams, concealed inside dates," it said in a post on X.

The passenger admitted to smuggling the gold paste and he arrested, it added. PTI
