



Assam: Two women asked to leave India within 24 hours

ASSAM'S INVOCATION of the 1950 Immigrants (Expulsion from Assam) Act is gathering steam, with the Biswanath district administration now issuing orders to two women, who were declared foreigners twenty years ago by tribunals, to "remove" themselves from

India within 24 hours.

This comes days after identical orders were issued to 15 men and women from Nagaon district on December 17. While police had confirmed that they were transported from the Matia 'transit camp' — Assam's designated detention camp to house "illegal foreigners" — on December 19 towards the Bangladesh border, there is no con-

firmation of their current whereabouts.

The Biswanath district administration issued orders to two women — Asmul Khatun and Afuja Begum — on December 20, stating that it is believed that "that being a Declared Foreign Nationals your presence in India/State of Assam is detrimental to the interest of the general public and

also for the internal security of the State."

Similar to the ones issued in Nagaon, the Biswanath orders invoke the 1950 Act and direct the individuals to "remove yourself from the territory of Assam, India within 24 hours from receiving this order via the Dhubri/Sribhumi/South Salmara-Mankachar route."

According to the orders, the

two women were declared foreigners by Foreigners Tribunals in Biswanath district in 2005.

Biswanath SP Ajagwan Basumatary said both women are currently under detention and are being held at the Matia centre. "Their deportation is under process, and will be undertaken in due time after receiving the green signal from the BSF," he said.

Kerala govt calls Chhattisgarh man's lynching fallout of 'Sangh's hate politics'

THE KERALA government on Monday promised a compensation of at least Rs 10 lakh to the family of the migrant worker from Chhattisgarh who was lynched by a mob in Palakkad last Wednesday. The government gesture came after the family of Ramnarayan Baghel, 31, a native of Sakti district of Chhattisgarh, refused to take his body home.

Meanwhile, after a video of the assault came to light in which one of the assailants is purportedly heard asking the man, "Are you a Bangladeshi?"

CP(M) leader from Palakkad and state local self government minister MB Rajesh said the migrant worker was a "victim of Sangh Parivar's hate politics". "He was attacked after being stigmatised as Bangladeshi. The assailants included RSS workers, who had faced criminal cases. The migrant worker who came in search of a job was tried and assaulted, accused of being a Bangladeshi. He is a victim of the racial hatred being spread by Sangh Parivar in the country," he claimed.

It was on Wednesday even-

ing that Baghel, who had reached Palakkad four days back in search of a job, was brutally attacked by a mob. Baghel, who was staying with his relative near Attappallam under Walyar police limits, reportedly lost his way and got stranded in the village where he was suspected of theft.

The visuals of him being questioned and attacked were caught on a phone. A postmortem report found that he had died due to loss of blood from internal injuries.

As relatives of the murdered youth refused to claim the body, revenue minister K Rajan on Monday held discussions with them and assured that the family would be paid "not less than an amount of Rs 10 lakh". A decision in this regard will be taken at the next cabinet meeting, he told the media in Thrissur after the meeting.

The state will also facilitate sending the body by air to Chhattisgarh.

Palakkad Superintendent of Police Ajith Kumar said a special investigation team has been formed to probe the case. "Five persons have been arrested, and a probe is on to verify the involvement of more people," he said.

NATIONAL HERALD CASE

HC seeks Rahul, Sonia response on ED plea against trial court order

THE DELHI High Court Monday sought the response of Lok Sabha LoP Rahul Gandhi, CPP chairperson Sonia Gandhi and others in the ED's plea challenging a trial court's verdict last week refusing to take cognisance of the agency's chargesheet in the National Herald money laundering case.

The HC also issued notice to director of Young Indian Saman Dubey, Sam Pitroda, Dotex Merchandise Pvt Ltd, and Sunil Bhandari. The matter will be heard next in March 2026.

On April 9 this year, the ED filed its chargesheet in the National Herald case. The trial court had refused to take cognisance on the grounds that the PMLA contemplates complaints by investigating officers from a probe agency, and not a private complaint from public persons.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the ED, submitted before Justice Ravinder Dubeja at the outset that if the trial court's order in the National Herald case is to be sustained, it would "affect several cases" while demonstrating "how the (trial) court has gone horribly wrong".

"Sum and substance of the impugned order is, 'if someone goes and files a one-page FIR before the police, that can be a subject matter of ED investigation. But if the competent court takes cognisance under section 200 of CrPC, that cannot be a ground on which cognisance can be taken.' That is how the court bifurcates... This order under challenge says if it is a private complaint, though the competent court has taken cognisance of offences which are scheduled offences, ED can do nothing, it is impermissible, it has to start with the FIR..." Mehta submitted.

"What is necessary is (as per the PMLA), there has to be an allegation, criminal activity pertaining to scheduled offence... whether the scheduled offence started with an FIR or a (private) criminal complaint, according to me, academically as well as practically, criminal complaint stands on a much higher footing than an FIR," the SG stated.
