PM calls for global compact on AI to prevent misuse at G20 Summit

Technology applications should be global rather than national, says Modi

JOHANNESBURG

Minister rime Narendra Modi on Sunday called for a global compact to prevent misuse of artificial intelligence and made a strong pitch for critical technologies to be human-centric, instead of finance-cen-

Addressing the third session of the G20 summit here, Modi also said technology applications should be 'global' rather than 'national', and based on 'open source' rather than 'exclusive models'.

PM Modi said that this vision has been integrated into India's technology ecosystem, and the same has resulted in significant benefits, be it in space applications, AI or digital payments, where it is a world leader.

He was addressing the third session of the G20 Summit on the topic "A Fair and a Just Future for All - Critical Minerals; Decent Work; Artificial Intelligence.

We must all ensure that AI is used for global good and its misuse is prevented. To do this, we must create a global compact on AI based on certain core principles, including effective human oversight, safety-by-design, transparency, and strict restrictions on the use of AI in deepfakes, crime, and terror activities, Modi

The Prime Minister said AI systems that impact human life, security, or public trust must be responsible and auditable.

And most importantly, AI should enhance human capabilities, but the ultimate responsibility for decision-making always remains with humans, he added.

Johannesburg: "You should have told us that it (hosting the G20 summit) is such a difficult task, maybe we would have run away," South African President Cvril Ramaphosa jokingly told Prime Minister Narendra Modi during their bilateral talks on Sunday. South Africa is hosting the first G20 Summit being held in Africa. In his opening remarks at the India-South Africa delegation-level talks, President Ramaphosa thanked India for its support in hosting the G20 leaders' summit. PM Modi speaks at IBSA meet

JOHANNESBURG

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday said the reform of the UN Security Council was no longer an option, but a necessity and asserted that the India-Brazil-South Africa troika should send a clear message for changes to institutions of global governance.

Addressing the India-Brazil-South Africa (IBSA) leaders summit here, Modi said that at a time when the world appears fragmented and divided, IBSA can provide a message of unity, cooperation, and humanity.

He also proposed institutionalising the IBSA NSAlevel meeting to strengthen security cooperation among the three countries.

"In the fight against terrorism, we must move forward in close coordination. There is no place for any double standards on such a serious issue," Modi said at the meeting attended by South Highlighting technology's crucial role in ensuring human-centric development, PM also proposed establishing an 'IBSA Digital Innovation Alliance' to facilitate the sharing of Digital Public Infrastructure like UPI, health platforms like CoWIN, cybersecurity frameworks and women-led tech initiatives among the three countries.

Appreciating IBSA Fund's work in supporting projects across 40 countries in sectors like education, health, women empowerment and solar energy, he proposed IBSA Fund for Climate Resilient Agriculture to further advance cooperation.

Modi called IBSA meeting as timely as it coincided with the first G20 Summit on African soil and marked the culmination of four consecutive G20 presidencies by Global South countries.

British Indian spy honoured with new postage stamp

Noor Inayat Khan, a descendent of the 18th-century Mysore ruler Tipu Sultan, has become the only Indian-origin woman to be honoured with a commemorative postage stamp by France for her role in the French Resistance as an undercover British agent during the Second World War. The French postal service, La Poste, honoured Noor with a stamp issued to honour the "Figures of the Resistance" who fought against Nazi Germany. She is among a dozen war heroes and heroines chosen on the set of stamps issued this month to mark 80 years since the end of World War II. "I am delighted that France has honoured Noor Inavat Khan with a postage stamp, especially as it comes on this important 80th anniversary of the end of the war," said Shrabani Basu, the London-based author of Noor's biography - 'Spy Princess: The Life of Noor Inayat

Lawyers protest against **Constitutional Amendment**

Protests against the 27th Constitutional Amendment continued in Pakistan, with many lawyers in Karachi entering the premises of the Sindh High Court (SHC), local media reported on Sunday. This was in defiance of directives issued by the SHC registrar, which prohibited the use of the court's premises for protests and rallies. The protesting lawyers held the protest at an open space on the premises of the SHC. While addressing the gathering, the lawyers' leadership slammed the implementation of the amendment and pledged to continue their protests for the independence of the judiciary and rule of law, an agency reported.
