

Kabirdham sets world record in water conservation drive

Chhattisgarh's Kabirdham district has created a world record in water conservation efforts by constructing a total of 1,02,098 soak pits in 999 villages within 12 hours, an official communique said on Friday.

Asia Head of the Golden Book of World Records Manoj Vishnoi presented the provisional world record certificate to Kabirdham Collector Gopal Verma.

This was done under the 'Mor Gaon-More Pani' campaign.

It received massive public support and resulted in this achievement. Across the state, soak pits are being constructed as part of a large-scale awareness drive on water conservation.

Collector Verma said that this success is a reflection of the collective consciousness and dedication of the people of the district.



The district has made another world record for a total of 1,17,504 people pledging to conserve water and protect the environment.

ACB nabs two govt officers for accepting bribes

The Anti-Corruption Bureau on Friday arrested two government officers for accepting bribes in Mungeli and Bastar districts of Chhattisgarh.

It includes Ajay Kumar Temburne and Krishna Kumar Gupta, ACB ASP Chandresh Thakur said.

Temburne was posted as Executive Engineer, Public Works Department (Electrical/Mechanical), Jagdalpur circle in Bastar district while Gupta was Junior Engineer, Chhattisgarh State Power Distribution Company Limited (CSPDCL) in Lormi in Mungeli district.

Temburne sought Rs 2 lakh from the complainant, who is a registered contractor there, for releasing his pending bills of electrification works.

Gupta demanded Rs 15,000 from the complainant for allegedly having illegal power connection in the latter's residence. The complainant had earlier



approached Gupta for getting a meter connection. Later, Gupta decided to visit his residence and there he sought money from the complainant. On receiving the complaints, the ACB sleuths laid traps and then caught Temburne and Gupta red handed while they were accepting bribe money. The two were booked and arrested under the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988.

Five Maoists involved in killing three civilians held

Five Maoists, involved in killing three civilians including two students, were arrested in Bijapur district of Chhattisgarh on Friday.

Ritesh Modiyam (25), Mitu Modiyam (18), his mother Ayati (50), Mangali Hapka (50) and Payki Modiyam (19), all hailed from Peddakorma village, have been taken into custody, Bijapur Superintendent of Police Jitendra Kumar Yadav said.

They were involved in killing three civilians including two students of Peddakorma village a couple of days ago.

They killed the victims in a kangaroo court (jan adalat).



Man suffering from a severely narrowed airway gets renewed life

A 36-year-old man suffering from subglottic stenosis, a severely narrowed airway condition, has received a fresh lease on life after undergoing tracheoplasty with anterior tracheal wall reconstruction.

An official communiqué said on Friday that a joint team from the ENT, Plastic Surgery, and Radiodiagnosis departments performed the surgery at Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Memorial Hospital in Raipur.

The patient was treated for an ascending colon perforation in September 2024. About 15 days later, he began experiencing difficulty breathing, which led to a tracheostomy.

Two months later, the tracheostomy tube was removed

and the surgical opening was closed. However, within 15 days, he again faced breathing issues and restlessness. A thorough diagnosis revealed tracheal stenosis, after which he was referred to Raipur.

The complex surgery was performed in two stages.

A face and neck scan revealed that the patient had a 2.4 cm long narrowing of the windpipe (tracheal narrowing) and a 7 mm complete stenosis (blockage) in his trachea.

On December 24, 2024, the tracheostomy was redone and the airway was reestablished.

The tracheoplasty with anterior tracheal wall reconstruction surgery was performed on May 16, 2025, in which the wall of the trachea was reconstructed using nasal septal cartilage.

The patient is on regular follow-ups and is leading a normal life.

Woman Maoist with Rs 8L bounty killed in Kanker

A woman Maoist, carrying a reward of Rs 8 lakh bounty on her head, was killed in a gunfight with security personnel in Kanker district in Chhattisgarh on Friday.

The gun battle ensued on a forested hill between Amatola and Kalpar villages in the Chhotabethiya area when a joint team of District Reserve Guard (DRG) and Border Security Force (BSF) was out on an anti-Naxal operation, Kanker Superintendent of Police Indira Kalyan Elesela said.

The operation was launched based on inputs about the presence of the members of the banned Maoist organisation near the Kotri River.

After the skirmish ended, the body of a woman Maoist iden-



tified as Shanti alias Deve, along with a .303 rifle, a BGL launcher, seven cartridges, a walkie-talkie set, Maoist literature and other items, was recovered from the encounter site.

Shanti carried a reward of Rs 8 lakh on her head.

North Bastar Division and was associated with activities of PLGA Company Number 5 and PLGA Company Number 7.

Further details with regard to the cadre profile and criminal cases against her are to be ascertained.

A search operation is being carried out in the nearby jungles to locate and apprehend other Maoist cadres who might have fled.

So far, 412 Maoists, including that of CPI Maoist General Secretary Basavaraju alias Ganganna and CCM Gautam alias Sudhakar, have been killed in the last 18 months in Bastar division.
