## Work will be done to make country a developed India by year 2047: Jagmohan Anand

MLA Jagmohan Anand highlighted upcoming programs to be held on occasion of 11 years of Central Government under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi "Sankalp se Siddhi Tak" and held a meeting of workers. He said that work will be done to make country a developed India by the year 2047 under leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chief Minister Naib Singh Saini. He said that a record export of \$825 billion dollars in goods and services has been registered in financial year 2024-25. Under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, 3.96 lakh kilometers of rural roads have been constructed since 2014. Number of operational airports in India has increased from 74 in 2014 to 160 in 2025. Similarly, under Udan scheme, 86 new airports were built and 88 destinations were connected. He said that 136 world-class Vande Bharat trains are being operated in the country. Projects like Delhi-Meerut Rapid Rail, the world's highest rail bridge on the Chenab river, the longest rail tunnel in the mountains,



rendra Modi has taken many big decisions to make life of middle class easier. These include 300 units of free electricity from Pradhan Mantri Surya Ghar Yojana, electricity connections have been installed in 100 percent of houses through Saubhagya Yojana. Under the leadership

of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, India's education system was made world-class through the National Education Policy 2020. Haryana has implemented NEP scheme first in country. ML said that under Ayushman Bharat scheme, 55 crore people were given free treatment up to Rs 5 lakh per year and senior citizens of 70 years or more have also benefited. 4 crore houses were built under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. Under the Har Ghar Jal Yojana, 15 crore rural families have got tap water. He said that under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana, 51 crore people have been given security coverage. Farmers are being given an annual assistance of Rs 6,000 every year through PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, so far Rs 3.7 lakh crore has been distributed to farmers under this scheme. He said that under Operation Sindoor, military self-reliance was demonstrated by destroying 9 terrorist hideouts across LoC and after removal of Article 370 and 35-A, Jammu and Kashmir has become completely integrated into constitutional and national structure of India.
