

### Indian Women's Team pays tribute to Pahalgam terror attack victims

Colombo: The Indian Women's Cricket Team wore black armbands during their Tri-Series opener against Sri Lanka in Colombo on Sunday to pay homage to the victims of the recent terror attack in Pahalgam, Jammu and Kashmir. The gesture was a mark of respect for the innocent lives lost and a show of solidarity with the affected families. The team responded strongly on the field, securing a dominant nine-wicket victory. Chasing a target of 148, India wrapped up the match in just 29.4 overs. Pratika Rawal starred with the bat, remaining unbeaten on 50 off 62 deliveries, including seven boundaries. Harleen Deol provided strong support, finishing not out on 48 as the duo comfortably guided India to the win. Earlier, Sneh Rana led the bowling attack with an impressive spell, picking up 3/31, which helped restrict Sri Lanka to 147. The tribute came in the wake of one of the deadliest attacks in Kashmir since 2019. On Tuesday, terrorists attacked tourists at the Baisaran meadow in Pahalgam, killing 25 Indian nationals and one Nepal citizen, and leaving several others injured. The incident has sent shockwaves across the nation and the international community. Following the attack, India has taken strong diplomatic steps against Pakistan, holding it responsible for continuing support to cross-border terrorism. Global leaders have also condemned the attack and expressed solidarity with India.

### "My desire is to return to Mohun Bagan, but it's not in my hands": Mumbai City FC's Prabir Das

Bhubaneswar : Prabir Das, currently with Mumbai City FC (MCOFC) on loan from Kerala Blasters FC (KBFC), has openly admitted his desire to return to Mohun Bagan, the club where he first made his name in Indian football. "Yes, if you ask me whether I want to be back, I would say everybody has that desire to play for Mohun Bagan, but desire is not everything -- you don't have control of your desires," Prabir told ANI. "If I have the desire to play for a club, can I just go? (laughs) It's not that simple. You have to adjust to the situation. It becomes tough and hard, but if you cannot adjust, you are finished," he added. Prabir, who rose to prominence after joining Mohun Bagan in 2016, emphasised that while players' emotions and passion are important, clubs often plan strategically for the future. Speaking about the possibility of rejoining Mohun Bagan, Prabir said, "It's not only my desire, there are many players like me who love Mohun Bagan."

"My desire alone doesn't mean anything. The club has its own plans; they will bring in young players to build for the future. My emotions and passion, which the fans appreciate, might push for my comeback, but the people who are building the team have different goals for the betterment of the club," he explained. "As a player, if you ask me, of course I would want to return but desire is not everything. Sometimes you have to accept the reality and move on," he said. While Prabir would love to stay in Kolkata, he acknowledged that a footballer's journey is often defined by external factors. "I would like to stay in Kolkata because I am from Kolkata," Prabir said.

## Suryakumar Yadav completes 4000 IPL runs

MUMBAI : Mumbai Indians batsman Suryakumar Yadav has crossed 4000 runs in the Indian Premier League (IPL) as he smashed a four off Avesh Khan to reach the feat. The MI superstar reached this milestone in Match 45 of IPL 2025 against Lucknow Super Giants at the Wankhede Stadium on Sunday.

He has accumulated another record in the match as he crossed 150 sixes in the IPL. Yadav accomplished the milestone with his initial maximum of the game off Ravi Bishnoi. Surya made 54 (28), before getting out to Avesh Khan in the 18th over his innings included four fours and four sixes. Lucknow Super Giants (LSG) captain Rishabh Pant won the toss and opted to bowl against Mumbai Indians (MI) on an action-packed

Sunday in the 18th edition of the Indian Premier League (IPL) at the Wankhede Stadium. Rohit Sharma and Ryan Rickelton opened the innings for Rohit started off from here. He left in Hyderabad against Sunrisers Hyderabad. he smashed two sixes off Mayank Yadav he faced. Mayank fought back and removed Rohit on a slower one, which Rohit played straight into the hands of short third man Will Jacks joined Rickelton in the middle. Rickelton powered MI to 66/1 in their first six overs. He made 49 inside the power-play, in just 24 balls. The duo of Rickelton and Jacks put on their 50-run partnership in 30 balls for the second wicket in the 8th over. Digvesh Rathi took the wickets of Ryan Rickelton for 58 (32) in the 9th over; his innings included six fours and four sixes. Surya Kumar Yadav joined Jacks in the middle, MI bought up their 100 in the 10th over. Prince Yadav gets the batter of Will Jacks on 29 (21) in the 12th over, his innings included three fours and a six. Tilak Varma joined Surya Kumar Yadav in the middle. After getting hammered for 16 runs in his last over, Ravi Bishnoi dismissed Tilak Varma for 6 (5) in the 13th over. MI skipper Hardik Pandya joined SKY in the middle.

### Sarah, Joshua emerge victorious at the TCS World 10K Bengaluru

Bengaluru : It was a day of delight for the Ugandan runners, as Sarah Chelangat and Joshua Cheptegei took home the top prize in their respective categories in TCS World 10K, a World Athletics Gold Label Road Race, held on Sunday. Incidentally, they were the first athletes from their country to take home the TCS World 10K titles, along with a prize of USD 26,000 each. When the women took the starting line-up at 5:30 am, a big question arose in the minds of fans and followers as eight of the best women with personal best timings faster than the event records set their foot on the Bengaluru roads. However, Sarah had a different strategy in mind as she broke away from the rest of the runners after the first two kilometres and maintained the lead thereafter. Sarah could easily be mistaken for a Kenyan, as Chelangat is a popular family name among them. She increased her pace once she parted from the rest of the field and passed through the halfway mark at 15:23s. At that stage, it was 20 seconds faster than that of Citlita and Ethiopians Guleni Shariko and Asmareah Angler. The gap started widening bigger and bigger thereafter, as Sarah had not looked back to see where her rivals were at any point in the race. With no one to push her, Sarah had to run her race and missed out on the event record by well over 30 seconds.

# MI defeat LSG by 55 runs: Bumrah's 4-wicket haul and Rickelton's fifty shine

**MUMBAI:** Jasprit Bumrah's brilliant four-wicket haul, along with Trent Boult's three-wicket performance, helped Mumbai Indians (MI) secure their fifth win of the ongoing Indian Premier League (IPL), defeating Lucknow Super Giants (LSG) by 55 runs at Wankhede Stadium on Sunday.

Chasing a target of 216, LSG began their innings with Mitchell Marsh and Aiden Markram. In the third over, MI's veteran bowler, Bumrah, dismissed Markram for just 9, surpassing the record of MI's bowling

coach Lasith Malinga (170 wickets) to become the highest wicket-taker for MI with 174 wickets.

Nicholas Pooran joined Marsh at the crease, and Pooran aggressively took on Deepak Chahar in the final over of the power-play, hitting him for three sixes. LSG finished their power-play on 60/1, with Pooran at 27\* and Marsh at 21\*.

Will Jacks made an impact in his first over, removing Pooran for 27 and LSG captain Rishabh Pant for just 4. Ayush Badoni then joined Marsh at the crease. Badoni took on Karan

Sharma in the 10th over, smashing him for two consecutive sixes, and LSG brought up their 100 in the same over.

On IPL debut for MI, Corbin Bosch bowled a brilliant first over, giving away only six runs, while Boult dismissed Marsh for 34 (24), including three fours and two sixes, in the 12th over.

Impact substitute David Miller joined Badoni at the crease, with LSG needing 93 runs off 42 balls. However, Boult got rid of Badoni for 35 (22), including two fours and two sixes, in the 15th over.

Bumrah took three wick-

ets in the 16th over, dismissing Miller for 24 (16), Abdul Samad for 2, and Avesh Khan for a duck. LSG now required 74 runs off the last four overs.

Bumrah finished with four wickets in his four overs, giving away just 22 runs. Corbin Bosch cleaned up Ravi Bishnoi for 13 (14) in the 19th over, and Boult removed Digvesh Rathi in the final over. LSG were all out for 161, falling short by 55 runs.

Apart from Bumrah and Boult, Will Jacks (2/18) and Corbin Bosch (1/26) contributed with the ball.

Earlier, MI posted a total

of 215/7 in 20 overs, thanks to impactful fifties from Ryan Rickelton (58) and Suryakumar Yadav (54). LSG captain Rishabh Pant won the toss and opted to bowl first.

Rohit Sharma and Rickelton opened for MI. Rohit started aggressively, hitting two sixes off Mayank Yadav. However, Mayank struck back, dismissing Rohit for 14 off a slower delivery, caught at short third man.

Rickelton took charge, blasting 49 runs off 24 balls inside the power-play, as MI reached 66/1 in the first six overs. He and Will Jacks (29 off 21) put together a 50-run partnership. However, Digvesh Rathi dismissed Rickelton for 58 off 32 balls, which included six fours and four sixes.

Suryakumar Yadav joined Jacks, and MI crossed 100 in the 10th over. Yadav played an explosive knock, making 54 off 28 balls, including four fours and four sixes, before being dismissed in the 18th over by Avesh Khan.

## Pratika Rawal's unbeaten 50-run knock guides India Women to victory over Sri Lanka by 9 wickets

Chasing a mere total of 148 runs, the Indian batters Pratika Rawal and Smriti Mandhana came out in the middle to open the innings for the side. Both players started off positively and attacked the bowlers from the first over. The Indian Women's Cricket Team completed the 50-run mark on the last ball of the ninth over as Pratika slammed a boundary on the bowling of Kavisha Dilhari.

At the score of 54, the Indian team lost the first wicket as Mandhana

was sent back to the pavilion after scoring 43 runs off 46 balls. The wicket was taken by left-arm spinner Inoka Ranaweera.

Following Mandhana's dismissal, right-hand batter Harleen Deol came out to bat in the middle along with Pratika.


The Women in Blue touched the 100-run mark in the 21st over as Harleen Deol smashed a boundary on the bowling Kavisha Dilhari.

The Harmanpreet Kaur-led side completed the chase in the 30th over with nine wickets in hand. Pratika Rawal and Harleen Deol remained unbeaten on the crease.

For Sri Lanka, Inoka Ranaweera (1/32 in 7.4 overs) was the only bowler to snap a wicket for the hosts.

Earlier in the first innings, the Chamari Athapaththu-led side were bundled out for 147 in 38.1 overs. The runs came from Hasini Perera (30) , Kavishi Dilhari (25), and Anushka Sanjeevani (22).

For India, three wickets were snapped by Sneh Rana, two wickets each were grabbed by Deepti Sharma and Nalappureddy Charani and one wicket was bagged by Arundhati Reddy in their respective spells
