

PR Sreejesh conferred Padma Bhushan by President Droupadi Murmu

New Delhi : Former Indian hockey star PR Sreejesh was honoured with the prestigious Padma Bhushan award by President Droupadi Murmu for his outstanding contribution to the field of sports. The official X handle of President of India posted, "President Droupadi Murmu presents Padma Bhushan in the field of Sports to Shri Sreejesh P.R. He is a former Indian Hockey goalkeeper and the current Coach of the Junior Indian Hockey team. Sreejesh is widely known for the double Olympic Bronze medals and for being the only hockey goalkeeper in the world to win the prestigious FIH Goalkeeper of the Year thrice during his 22-year playing career." The Padma Awards are among the highest civilian honours in India and are given in three categories: Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan, and Padma Shri. These awards recognise exceptional achievements in various fields such as art, social work, public affairs, science and engineering, trade and industry, medicine, literature and education, sports, and civil service. The Padma Vibhushan is awarded for exceptional and distinguished service, the Padma Bhushan for distinguished service of a high order, and the Padma Shri for distinguished service in any field. The awards are announced annually on the occasion of Republic Day. For the year 2025, the President approved the conferment of 139 Padma Awards, including a duo case (where an award is counted as one).

IPL 2025: Chawla underscores importance of Virat's fifty, decodes reason behind RCB's away dominance

New Delhi: Former India spinner Piyush Chawla feels that irrespective of the way batting maestro Virat Kohli managed his way to fifty, Royal Challengers Bengaluru stood in a position where they needed someone to play the anchor's role, especially after Delhi Capitals rattled their top-order. During RCB's pursuit of 163, Delhi roared back with aplomb and reduced the visitors to 26/3, leaving them rattled after the fourth over. RCB's batting depth was up for a test, and Krunal Pandya and Virat ensured their side passed gracefully with flying colours. Virat and Krunal inspired Bengaluru to the top of the table by stitching up an impeccable 119-run stand to safely guide the Royal Challengers through the turbulent phase. Throughout the partnership, Virat heavily relied on stroke rotation and occasionally set his eyes on the boundary rope. He returned to the dugout with 51(47) after trying to dispatch the ball with an inside-out shot but could n't clear the boundary rope. Dushmanta Chameara's length delivery, well outside off, did the trick, with Mitchell Starc calmly completing the catch to end Virat's stay at the crease. Chawla outlined the importance of Virat's knock even though it didn't meet the current T20 standard and said on JioHotstar, "No matter how Virat has scored his 50 runs, what's important is getting those crucial two points in the points table. RCB wanted somebody to anchor the innings – the score wasn't that big." "Especially after losing three wickets, you need someone to anchor and not lose too many wickets from one end so the others can revolve around you. That's exactly what Virat has done. Those 51 runs were as crucial as those 160-170 chases and will give the team a great platform to chase," he added.

DC eye improved middle-overs batting show against struggling KKR

AGENCY NEW DELHI: Delhi Capitals would aim for an improved batting effort in the middle overs when they face a struggling Kolkata Knight Riders in their Indian Premier League match here on Tuesday.

DC have suffered two defeats in their last four matches, including a loss to Royal Challengers Bengaluru on Sunday, and will look to avoid any hiccups at the business end of the tournament.

Abhishek Porel has batted with plenty of aggressive intent at the top of the order but veteran Fafu Plessis will quickly need to get used to the slow nature of surface at Kotla after struggling in his comeback game.

KL Rahul has been DC's leading run-getter this season but could not accelerate against the spinners on Sunday night. He would back himself to take on the likes of Sunil Narine and Varun Chakaravathy..

With quality spinners in



their ranks, KKR could pose a stiff challenge for the home. The Ajinkya Rahane led-side is slightly low on confidence after a tough outing against Punjab Kings in a rain-hit match.

A solid innings is expected from Karun Nair to ensure Rahul isn't left to shoulder the burden alone in the middle-order.

In the bowling department, DC skipper Axar Patel

led from the front with two wickets but found little support from others.

Star pacer Mitchell Starc, who went wicketless against RCB, will look to exploit the weaknesses in his former team, while Kuldeep Yadav, with his deceptive googlies, remains a threat in the middle-overs.

DC's fielding has also left much to be desired against RCB, with Porel dropping a

crucial catch of Krunal Pandya on Sunday night.

KKR, meanwhile, have managed just seven points so far and are placed seventh in the standings, having failed to collect any points from their last three matches, including two losses and a no-result.

Rahane will be desperate to arrest the slide and keep their playoff hopes alive, with another defeat making

the task tougher.

Issues have cropped up across departments for KKR.

Their batting lacks a settled look, with Quinton de Kock and Rahmanullah Gurbaz being rotated in the opening slot alongside Narine, while the side has relied heavily on Rahane and youngster Angkrish Raghuvanshi to score runs.

The middle-order trio of Venkatesh Iyer, Andre Russell, Rinku Singh and Ramandeep Singh has struggled to make a significant impact.

Bowling has been another area of concern, with KKR failing to break opening stands, allowing teams to post big totals — as seen in the last game where PBKS added 120 for the opening wicket.

While KKR managed to pull things back at the death, it will require a collective effort from Chakaravathy, Vaibhav Arora, and Harshit Rana to stem the flow of runs against DC.

Over the course of his career, he has established himself as a key player for the Indian cricket

team, known for his exceptional skills as an all-rounder. The Padma Shri is one of the highest civilian honours in India, awarded for distinguished service in various fields such as arts, education, industry, literature, science, sports, medicine, social service, and public affairs. Ashwin's recognition with the Padma Shri reflects his significant contributions to Indian cricket and his continued impact on the sport. Ashwin has been one of the illustrious spinners in the world of cricket. He announced his retirement after the third Test of the Border-Gavaskar Trophy in Australia. In 106 Tests for India, the legendary all-rounder took 537 wickets at an average of 24.00, with best figures of 7/59. He claimed 37 five-wicket hauls and eight ten-wicket match hauls in his Test career. He is the eighth-highest wicket-taker in Tests overall and the second-highest for India, behind Anil Kumble (619 wickets).
