Wimbledon champion Krejčíková suffers first-round defeat at Queen's Club

London, June 11 (UNI) Defending Wimbledon champion Barbora Krejčíková failed to reach the second round at Queen's Club, as the 29-year-old Czech lost to Rebecca Sramkova of Slovakia 6-4, 6-3 at the WTA 500 event here. Krejčíková started her campaign at Queen's Club in west London as the seventh seed in the women's singles main draw, but was outplayed by 28-year-old Sramkova after one hour and 15 minutes on Tuesday.

Last year, Krejčíková celebrated her first Grand Slam win since the French Open in 2021, but withdrew from this year's Australian Open due to a back injury and had been out of action until May. World No. 41 Sramkova's next opponent is Emma Raducanu, as the home favorite smashed Spanish qualifier Cristina Bucsa 6-1, 6-2. "I think it was a very clean performance. I'm really pleased with what I was able to put out on the court despite any first-round nerves," said the 22-year-old former U.S. Open champion.

Raducanu's compatriots Katie Boulter and Heather Watson also enjoyed opening-round wins in front of their home crowd. Boulter, 28, edged out Alja Tomljanovic 7-6(4), 1-6, 6-4 after battling against the Australian qualifier in two hours and 21 minutes.

WI coach Sammy on Nicholas Pooran's international retirement

Southampton: West Indies white-ball head coach Daren Sammy broke silence on star batter Nicholas Pooran's retirement from international cricket, saying that "more will follow in that direction" and his instincts told him that "something like that would happen". Pooran's decision comes days after he requested Cricket West Indies not to consider him for their ongoing white-ball tour of England. With over eight months left before the T20 World Cup 2026 kicks off in India and Sri Lanka, Pooran's decision serves as a massive setback for the 2016 winners. Since bursting onto the international scene in 2016, Pooran featured in 106 T20Is and 61 ODIs, both garnering more than 4,258 runs across both formats. He mustered up 2,275 in the shortest format of cricket, averaging 26.14 at 136.39. While in the 50-over cricket, he tallied 1,983 runs at 39.66 while maintaining a strike rate of 99.15, leaded with three centuries and 11 fifties.

Speaking as quoted by ESPNcricinfo, Sammy said after 0-3 loss to England in T20Is. "My instincts told me something like that would happen. Nicholas sent me a text message, and so did I had a conversation with his agent as well... When we first spoke about the UK tour and the conversation I had with him, I did ask him, 'Are you unavailable for the UK tour only, or indefinitely?' And from that response, I just knew I had to start preparing for the worst case."

UTT Season 6: U Mumba TT eye playoffs, Dabang Delhi TTC chase history in final league stage tie

AGENCY AHMEDABAD : U Mumba TT will have their sights set on a semi-final berth when they take on playoffs-bound Dabang Delhi TTC in the Ultimate Table Tennis (UTT) Season 6 on Thursday. There is a lot on the line for Delhi, too, who are aiming to become the first team in history to pass through the league stage unbeaten. U Mumba sit fifth on the table with 32 points; their playoff chances rest not just on a win, but also on the outcome of the Jaipur Patriots vs PBG Pune Jaguars tie. Five games might be enough, but nothing less than a fight will do for the team from Mumbai. They come in buoyed by a gritty win over Stanley's Chennai Lions, with Bernadette Szocs, Lilian Bardet, and Yashaswini Ghorpade all in strong



form. Szocs and Bardet have each won three of their four matches, while Yashaswini—who beat China's Fan Siqi in her previous outing—has won two of three. The Szocs-Akash Pal pairing has been a revelation, winning three straight in mixed doubles. Though Akash is yet to win a singles match, his doubles presence remains key. Bardet and Szocs rank among the league's top forehand shot-makers, while Yashaswini has been a backhand machine. Dabang Delhi, meanwhile, have already locked in their playoff berth, but a win here would etch their names in UTT history. They've been consistently clinical: Diya Chitale, Sathiyann Gnanasekaran, Maria Xiao, and Izaac Quek have all won at least two matches each, delivering consistent returns.

WTC final: Rabada's fifer floors Australia for 212, South Africa gain early edge

Steve Smith began the post lunch session in a positive way for the Aussie featuring a resilient fifty by Steve Smith who continued to inspire the innings in a crucial tie for the side. The duo kept finding the boundaries at regular intervals and went on to rotate the strike along the way as well.

Steve Smith overtakes Tendulkar to reach closer to Virat Kohli's ICC knockout matches record

LONDON : Australian batting icon Steve Smith overtook legendary Indian cricketer Sachin Tendulkar, climbing up to the second spot among batters with the highest number of fifty-plus scores in ICC tournament knockout matches. Smith continues solidifying his legacy as the ultimate clutch batter for Australia, with yet another half-century against the Proteas during the ICC World Test Championship (WTC) final at Lord's. Walking in with Australia at 16/2, Smith's fluency was on showcase as he scored 66 in 112 balls, with 10 fours. His runs came at a strike rate of 58.92. This is Smith's seventh fifty-plus score in ICC event knockout matches, overtaking Tendulkar, who had six such scores in 15 matches, scoring 682 runs at an average of 48.71 with a century and five fifties. Smith loses out to Tendulkar in volume of runs, scoring 650 runs in 13 matches and innings at an average of 59.09, with two centuries and nine fifties. His best score is 121. India's Virat Kohli remains the undisputed king of ICC knockout matches, being the only player to have made 1,000 runs in such matches. He has made 1,024 runs in 22 matches and 24 innings at an average of 51.20, with a century and nine fifties (a total of 10 fifty-plus scores) and best score of 117 against New Zealand in the 2023 World Cup semifinal at Mumbai.

India players engage in intense fielding drills filled with banter ahead of England Tests



AGENCY LONDON : Indian players engaged in intense fielding drills, which were topped up by a fun banter between the players as they continued to fortify their preparations for the upcoming Test series against England.

Fielding coach T Dilip orchestrated the fielding drills, which involved taking low and high catches and hitting the stumps from a distance, in a video posted by the BCCI. Vice-captain Rishabh Pant's throw was a whisker away from hitting the stump, and he expressed his agony by saying, "Arey yaar."

In one instance, Indian Test captain Shubman Gill was impressed when his Gujarat Titans teammate Sai Sudharsan took a sharp catch and said, "Catching yaar." Towards the end of the video, Mohammed Siraj celebrated by jumping in the air after cleanly completing a catch.

After batting wizards Rohit Sharma and Virat Kohli bid adieu to Test cricket last month, India was left short on experience. With India bereft of its torchbearers, the management turned to youngsters to mark the beginning of a new era.

The five-test tour of England starts June 20 at Leeds and lasts until August 2025. With India lining up without its batting bigwigs Rohit and Virat following their retirement from the game's longest format, the onus lies on the Shubman-led revamped side to prove itself away from home in testing and gruelling English conditions.

The series will be held from June to August, with matches scheduled at Headingley in Leeds, Edgbaston in Birmingham, Lord's and The Oval in London, and Old Trafford in Manchester.
