## District admin committed to stop illegal mining and transportation: DC

He said that during the checking of 2076 vehicles by the district administration and mining department in the district, 2 vehicles were challaned and a fine of Rs 4 lakh 49 thousand was imposed. As per the instructions of the Haryana government, strict action will be taken against people doing illegal mining in the state. For this, monitoring is being done by forming teams at different levels. He said that the administration is committed to stop illegal mining and transportation in the district and proper efforts are continuously going on. The Deputy Commissioner said that 1349 vehicles were checked by the teams of SDM Chhachhrauli. Similarly, 250 vehicles were checked by the teams of SDM Jagadhari. He informed that 295 vehicles were checked by the teams of SDM Radaur. Similarly, during the checking of 182 vehicles by the team of SDM Vyaspur, 2 vehicles were challaned and 1 vehicle was seized and a fine of Rs 4 lakh 49 thousand was imposed.
