CM Saini reviews development projects in Gurugram

Haryana Chief Minister Sh Nayab Singh Saini while presiding over a review meeting on the various development projects in Gurugram district on Thursday, instructed concerned officials to expedite the implementation of major state government projects and ensure their timely completion. He said that officers must ensure high-quality work while maintaining a swift pace, and not allow any laxity in the development process.

The meeting was attended by Industry and Commerce Minister Rao Narbir Singh, Sohna MLA Tejpal Tanwar, Chief Secretary Anurag Rastogi (via video conference), and Principal Advisor Mr. D.S. Dhesi.

After receiving a detailed report on the sewerage, drainage, sanitation, water supply, construction and demolition (C&D) waste, and road systems from the relevant departmental



officers, the Chief Minister said that development of infrastructure is very important to establish new dimensions of development in the district. He urged all departments to work in coordination and ensure that the stipulated timelines for these projects are adhered to. He further stated that since the government is accountable to the public, it is crucial that officials regularly monitor the progress of all ongoing development projects. In cases where delays

are caused by the concerned agencies, he said that penalties should be imposed and FIRs be filed.

While reviewing the cleanliness system in the corporation area, the Chief Minister said that Gurugram is a key driver of the state's economic development. He said that it is our collective moral responsibility to ensure the city remains clean and beautiful. To address the issue of manpower, the Chief Minister suggested

that sanitation workers could be engaged as needed in the relevant areas through the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam. The meeting also included in-depth discussions on improving the door-to-door garbage collection system in the corporation area. Instructing the officers of Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA), the Chief Minister said that the renovation work on all roads must be completed promptly to ensure a smooth and safe traffic system for the public. He said that there is still ample time before the monsoon season, and therefore, officers should ensure the work is completed by the end of June.

The meeting also revealed that GMDA manages 284.5 km of road, with 135 km of road renovation already completed. Following the removal of GRAP restrictions, renovation work on an additional 100 km of roads commenced on February 15 and is expected to be completed within the stipulated timeframe.

Dr Dheeraj Kaushik presents research paper on Haryana

Secretary of Indian History Compilation Committee Haryana and Acharya of Bhagwan Parshuram College Kurukshetra, Dr. Dheeraj Kaushik presented a research paper on Haryana as the birthplace of Indian culture and neglect of Haryana history in the two-day Ninth Young Historian National Seminar of All India History Compilation Scheme, Jannardan Rai University, Udaipur. He said in his research paper that Haryana state has a very important place in Indian history. The greatness of any state does not depend on its geographical size but on the contribution of that state in national life. This state has made an invaluable contribution in the development of Indian culture and civilization. The first sprouts of Indian culture sprouted with the creation of Vedic literature on the banks of Adi Saraswati. This culture flourished and progressed towards development due to the efforts of the Brahmin Gyani here. The illustrious Bharat, Puru and Kuru people here spread



the immortal message of this culture far and wide. In the medieval period, Hansi, Panipat, Karnal and Thanesar developed as intellectual literature centers.

Along with Persian, literature

was continuously created in Prakrit, Sanskrit, Hindi and Urdu. For a long time, this state has been contributing much more than its capacity in various aspects of national life. But at present, the writing work on the history and culture of Haryana at the university level has been stopped by scholars. At present, the irrefutable evidence of Haryana has been ignored by secular writers and historians of a particular class.

He further said that the government and non-government institutions of the country have been negligent in giving research projects and grants to the historians of Haryana. Regional centers have been established inside universities in different states of the country, whereas the lack of regional centers is seen in any university of Haryana. At present, it is the responsibility of young historians to reconsider the writing of history of Haryana state, and include those events in it which were left out by historians.
