twerp: With a 0-2 loss agains elgium, the Indian Women's Hockey am suffered its sixth defeat in the European leg of the FIH Pro League or Sunday. Goals by Ambre Ballenghien (40') and Lien Hillewaert (43') saw Belgium regis a win against the Indian Women's Hockey Team in Antwerp, according to a release fro Hockey India.

This win ensured Belgium remained in third place, behind the Netherlands and Argentina, who are in first and second place, res ectively After Saturday's 1-5 debacle against Belgium India began the first quarter showcasing aggressive play with a clear intent to rcome the disappointment of the previous

Rishabh Pant becomes third Indian to take 150 Test catches as wicketkeeper

eeds : Indian star Rishabh Pant complete 150 catches as a designated wicketkeepe making him the third from his team to do so. Pant reached this milestone during the third day of the first Test against England at Leeds on Sunday. After Prasidh Krishna struck early, removing Ollie Pope after an edge off his bat anded into Pant's hands, the 27-year-old reached a milestone only touched previously by Syed Kirmani (160 catches) and MS Dhoni (256) among Indians. Now, Pant has a total of 151 catches and 15 stumpings (166 dismis making him the third most successful keeper for India in history. Dhoni is the most successful one with 256 catches and 38 stumpings, totalling to 294 dismissals. At the end of the first sess England was 327/5, with Brook (57*) and Smith (29*) unbeaten. Jasprit Bumrah's five wicket haul ends England innings on 465 at Tea; India lead by 6 runs

LEEDS : A brilliant five-wicket haul from Jasprit Bumrah, the backbone of India's bowling line-up, bowled out England on 465 in their first innings at tea, giving India a lead of six runs on Day 3 in the first test at Headingley, Leeds.

The duo of Chris Woakes and Brydon Carse's counter-attacking partnership has helped England stop India from taking a big lead after Harry Brook fell on 99

England started the second session

at 327-5, Harry Brook 57 (77) and Jamie Smith 29 (45). England batters took the charge on Indian bowlers, scoring 16 off the first two overs post lunch.

Prasidh Krishna, after being smashed for a six by Jamie Smith, was

removed for 40 in the following over. Chris Woakes joined Brook in the mid-Yashasvi Jaiswal dropped an easy

catch of Harry Brook in the 85th over off Jasprit Bumrah. This was the fourth catch going down to Bumrah's bowling. Brook, after the drop catch,

took on Mohammed Sirai in the following over, smashing him for 18 runs.

Krishna removed Brook on 99 in the 88th over. He missed a welldeserved 100 as Brook tried to pull the ball for a six but was caught on deep square leg. Brydon Carse joined Woakes in the middle.

In the same over, England crossed the 400 runs mark, trailing behind by 68 runs. The duo of Carse and Woakes took on the Indian bowlers following Brook's wicket-smashing 31 runs in just four overs

Carse and Woakes brought up their 50-run partnership in the 94th over off just 36 balls. Siraj cleaned up Carse for 22, his innings included four fours, and Josh Tongue joined Woakes in the middle. England crossed the 450 runs mark in the same. Bumrah cleaned up Woakes in the 99th over for 38. His innings included three fours and two sixes. Shoaib Bashir joined Tongue in the middle.

Won't be easy for Virat and Rohit to play 2027 WC: Ganguly

KOLKATA: It won't be easy for Virat Kohli and Rohit Sharma to remain fit and find a place in India's ODI World Cup squad in 2027, former captain Sourav Ganguly says.

"All of us must understand, just like everyone, the game will go away from them and they will go away from the game," Ganguly told PTI in a lengthy interview at his residence.

The next ODI World Cup is scheduled in South Africa, Zimbabwe and Namibia and by the time the prestigious ICC event is played Kohli will be 38 years old and Rohit will touch 40.

Till then India have 27 ODIs to play spread across nine bilateral series. That means Kohli and Rohit will hardly get 15 international games a year.

"It won't be easy, with 15 games a year," Ganguly said.

With 25,000 runs and 83 international hundreds between them, both Kohli and Rohit have expressed their desire to play the 50-
