Black marketing of fertilizers on rise in Yamunanagar: Shyam Sundar Batra

YAMUNANAGAR: Serious allegations of black marketing of fertilizer meant for farmers have surfaced in Yamunanagar. Congress leader Shyam Sundar Batra, directly targeting the government and the administration, said that there was open black marketing of fertilizer in the state. The situation is such that while a bag of fertilizer should be available at the government rate, it is being sold in the market for Rs 700 - 800. Batra said that instead of helping the farmers, the government was promoting profiteers. He alleged that such black marketing was not possible without administrative connivance. He said that if the government's intentions were clear the farmers would have got fertilizers on time and at cheap rates, but here they were being cheated. The Congress leader warned that if black marketing was not stopped immediately otherwise farmers will be forced to take to the streets. He demanded that strict action should be taken against the culprits and adequate quantity of fertilizers should be made available to the farmers at reasonable rates.



Role of EC under suspicion is threat to democracy: Inderjit Goraya

KARNAL: All India Kisan Congress national spokesperson and member of the State Congress Committee Inderjit Singh Goraya, while accusing the BJP's Modi government, said that ever since these people have come to power, they are engaged in weakening the constitutional institutions of the country. Inderjit Goraya said that the foundation of democracy in the country rests on the principle of one person one vote. In the last few years, efforts are being made to shatter this principle, strong evidence of which has been presented by former Congress Party President and Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi through the press before the Election Commission and the people of the country. The Election Commission should have been neutral and should have investigated these allegations impartially. It should have conducted an investigation so that the people of the country could have faith in the system of fair elections, but instead of this, it seems that the Election Commission itself has gone under the protection of the government. The collusion between the Election Commission and the BJP government is being proved by the fact that the government ministers and BJP spokespersons are responding to the allegations against the Election Commission. Leader of Opposition Rahul Gandhi has given evidence of a person making and casting votes at two and three places, which cannot be denied in any way.
