Severe and exemplary punishment must be given to perpetrator of hate crime against sikh elder in USA: Jathedar Gargajj

SRI AMRITSAR (CHARANJIT SINGH ARORA): Giani Kuldip Singh Gargajj, Officiating Jathedar of Sri Akal Takht Sahib and

Jathedar of Takht Sri Kesgarh Sahib, strongly condemned the brutal hate attack on 70-year-old Sikh, S. Harpal Singh, in North Hollywood, California, USA. He stated that the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) and American investigative agencies must ensure the accused person receives a strict and exemplary punishment. Jathedar Gargajj said it is essential to understand the intent be hind the attack and that it should be recorded as a hate crime.

According to information, S. Harpal Singh was walking near Saticoy Street and Lankershim Boulevard when an individual attacked him with a golf club, inflicting severe injuries. He is currently

battling for his life in hospital. A suspect has been apprehended by the LAPD and the police must reveal his motive behind this attack. Jathedar Gargajj noted that, according to the FBI's 2024 hate crime report, while hate crimes against Sikhs in the USA have slightly decreased, Sikhs remain the third most-targeted religious group, which is a grave concern. The FBI report records 153 hate crime incidents against Sikhs in 2024 alone. He stressed the urgent need for collaborative efforts worldwide, including in the USA, to raise awareness about Sikh identity in order to curb such attacks.
