E-compensation portal open till Sept 15 for crop loss claims: SDM

YAGYADUTT SHASTRI PEHOWA: Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) Abhinav Siwach, IAS, has informed that the state government has extended the e-compensation portal deadline till September 15, 2025, following the announcement by Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini. The extension has been given keeping in view the hardships caused to farmers by recent rains, waterlogging, and heavy downpours. Farmers whose crops have been affected during Kharif 2025 can register their claims online on the portal. Siwach said that revenue officers will verify the claims through special girdawari and compensation will be provided according to the prescribed standards. He appealed to all affected farmers to take advantage of the extended deadline and register their losses at the earliest. As per the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) guidelines, damages caused by floods, waterlogging, and heavy rains are eligible for claims on the e-compensation portal. Once claims are filed, revenue officials up to the level of SDM will assess crop losses and initiate the compensation process.

GOLDY CHUGH SHAHABAD: A new and easy method of modern family planning has been started for women in Adesh Medical College and Hospital located in Mohri. Giving information, hospital's gynecologist Dr. Satwant Kaur said that a contraceptive process called Implanon NXT has been started in Adesh Hospital, which is very easy and cheap and this process is completed in just five minutes. She said that once the treatment is taken with this process, it provides protection from pregnancy for three consecutive years and its success rate is about 100 percent. Dr. Satwant Kaur said that this process is considered more effective than permanent measures like sterilization.

Contribution of all essential to keep Saraswati pilgrimage site clean: SDM Abhinav Siwach



YAGYADUTT SHASTRI PEHOWA: Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) Abhinav Siwach, IAS, has stressed the need for collective efforts of social and religious organizations to maintain cleanliness at the sacred Saraswati pilgrimage site. Questions raised on 'private public hearing' in rest house, farmer leaders seek action



MAINPAL KASHYAP INDR: Controversy over an alleged 'private public hearing' going on in Irrigation Department's rest house in Indri is deepening. Rinku Kalsaura, Sumit Kumar, Rajiv, Vishal, Rajesh Aashik, Advocate Dharm Singh Sandhu, social worker Rajbir have made serious allegations against Mandal President Vijay Kumar and said that he has been using departmental rest house as a private office for a long time, which is completely against rules. Leaders alleged that Vijay Kumar conducts public hearing of people by sitting in rest house every day, whereas this building is meant for government use, not for private activities of any particular person. He said that such use of government properties in private interest is not only a violation of administrative rules, but it also promotes corruption. According to information received from department, no permission has been given for any type of permanent private office or regular public hearing in the said rest house.

All district roads to be made pothole-free by Sept 15: DC Parth Gupta



RAHUL KOHLI YAMUNANAGAR: Deputy Commissioner Parth Gupta on Tuesday directed officials of various departments to ensure that all urban and rural roads in the district are repaired and made pothole-free by September 15. Chairing a review meeting at the camp office, Gupta said that heavy rainfall had caused extensive damage to roads, leading to potholes that were inconveniencing commuters. He instructed officials from the Public Works Department (Buildings and Roads), National Highways Authority of India (NHAI), Urban Local Bodies, Development and Panchayat Department, Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board, and the Zila Parishad to expedite patchwork and repair works before the onset of Navratri. "To ensure smooth movement for the public, every department must complete road repair works on priority. No road should remain in a dilapidated condition," the DC stressed. For effective monitoring, Gupta deputed 14 officers to inspect pothole-filling and patchwork progress across the district.

Transformer stolen from farmer's tubewell in Kandoli; police urged to catch thieves

VIJAY KAUSHIK BABAIN: In a theft incident at Kandoli village under Babain police station, unknown thieves stole the copper coil from an electric transformer installed on farmer Arud Chand Mata's tubewell. The theft occurred last night when the farmer had left for home. The next morning, Rajeev Kumar, who is cultivating land on lease, found the transformer lying in his paddy field with its copper coil removed. The transformer's oil spilled into the field, posing a risk to the paddy crop. Rajeev Kumar said that due to the theft, the tubewell is now non-functional, affecting irrigation for his crops. He added that incidents of theft involving electricity equipment and tubewell motors have been frequent in the Babain area, yet no effective action has been taken by the police. Rajeev Kumar and Baldev Singh have urged the authorities to apprehend the culprits. Krishna Chand Kalal Majra, district head of Bhakiyu, condemned the incident, stating that thefts like these are a serious setback for farmers already struggling with high costs and natural challenges. He demanded strict action against those stealing tubewells and transformers.



Villagers seek permanent solution of waterlogging on underpass route

JITENDRA KAUSHIK BARWALA: A shed was constructed on underpass route for safe movement of villagers under National Highway-7. Even after this, villagers did not get relief from problem of rain waterlogging on underpass route. Due to this, villagers have to cross four-lane highway risking their lives. Former Sarpanch of Rihaur village Rajneesh Sharma, Prince Kaushik, Harinder Kumar, Rajesh Kumar and others said that a shed was constructed on underpass route by spending about Rs 21 lakh, but even after this, rain water is filling in underpass. There is anger among villagers due to problem not being resolved. They demanded government and district administration to take immediate cognizance of this.
