The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) is organizing the 29th Conference of Central and State Statistical Organizations (CoCSSO) on 25th and 26th September, 2025 at Chandigarh.The conference serves as a major forum for coordination between Central and State Statistical Agencies, with the objective of ensuring reliable, timely, and credible statistics for planners, policymakers, and the public to support evidence-based decision-making. COCSSO has played an important role in strengthening Centre-State coordination since 1971. The theme of this year's COCSSO is 'Strengthening Local Level Governance'. The conference has brought together around 350 participants from more 30 States/ than Departments [Planning, DES & Statistical Organizations]; Central Ministries/ Departments, experts from various other national & international organizations such as Indian Statistical



Institute Indian Agricultural Statistics Research Institute (IASRI), Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), international organisations such as World Bank, UN agencies and other stakeholders to deliberate on strengthening statistical systems for evidence-based governance and achieving the vision of Viksit Bharat.

#### **HSNCB** seizes 15 grams of heroin, arrests trafficker near Bastada Toll Plaza

KARNAL: As part of the ongoing campaign to make Haryana a drug-free state, the Haryana State Narcotics Control Bureau (HSNCB), Karnal unit, achieved another success. Acting on a tip-off, the team apprehended a drug trafficker near Bastada Toll Plaza, Gharaunda (GT Road), and recovered 15 grams of heroin from his possession. Under the strict guidance of Bureau Chief and Director General of Police, O.P. Singh, IPS, decisive action against drug traffickers is being carried out across the state. The DGP emphasized, "Eradicating the roots of drug abuse is our highest priority, and no laxity will be tolerated." This arrest reflects the bureau's commitment to a drug-free Haryana. The operation was conducted under the supervision of SP Mohit Handa, IPS, and DSP Manoj Kumar. During patrol, SI Vinod Kumar and his team received the tip-off. After verifying the information, the police strategically apprehended the suspect. Following proper legal procedure, a gazetted officer was present during the search, leading to the recovery of 15 grams of heroin. The arrested individual is a resident of Panipat district.

### **Govt paddy procurement** begins at grain market



INDRI: Government procurement process for paddy has officially begun at grain market from Birwar. Although government had announced paddy procurement from September 22, process could not begin due to procurement agencies' unpreparedness and high moisture content. Now, with favorable weather and improved paddy quality, procurement operations have begun on September 25. Before commencing procurement operations, inspectors from HAFED, Warehouse and Food and Supplies Department held a meeting chaired by Market Secretary Jasbir Singh to review entire system. Meeting was attended by market administration, president and secretary of Rice Mill Association, and representatives from all three procurement agencies. A detailed strategy was developed for smooth operation of procurement process. A joint team of officials visited market and inaugurated procurement process. Procurement agency officials stated that, as per government standards, only paddy with a maximum moisture content of 17 percent will be purchased.
