Together this team of talented and committed individuals manage a multitude of tasks on a daily basis and a host of specialised functions to ensure smooth and seamless working of the organisation on a larger scale. Let's take a look:

- Management of cash and cash equivalents by maintaining a daily cash flow and deploying surplus funds in order to maximize returns while maintaining adequate safety and liquidity
- Fund raising from banks and other financial institutions as well as refinance from National Housing Bank, International Development Institution, financial corporations, insurance companies and mutual funds while meeting the related compliances related to sanctions
- · Maintaining an ongoing relationship with lenders and scheduling meetings with them
- Maintaining a daily association with banks and providing them with information as and when required, including submission of various documents to banks on monthly/quarterly basis such as UFCE, due diligence report etc



- Maintaining a relationship with rating agencies by providing the required information with due diligence and scheduling meetings for them, with the senior management team and customers, as well as branch visits
- Managing issuance of non-convertible debentures/rupee denominated bonds by executing the required documentation, providing information to the debenture holder/investor and debenture trustee as and when required and paying the interest and principal as and when it is due
- Managing direct assignment transactions with the banks by providing the documents and information to the bankers as and when required and ensuring timely receipt of pool money
- Other activities include international payments of all the departments, exploring other options to raise funds and maintaining MIS for debt, investment etc

We, as an organisation, are grateful to the team who impeccably accomplish, for Aavas, significant goals on a daily basis, thus helping us reach several milestones in the long run.

- Aavas is the fourth housing finance company to raise the funds in the form of rupee denominated bonds in unsecured form for a period of 7 years
- Despite various negative events in debt market starting right from ILFS issue, non rollover of CPs for HFC and NBFC, DHFL fiasco, tightening of liquidity and increase in G Sec yields, MCLRs and higher spread premium for lending to NBFCs/HFCs, Aavas was able to maintain its COB at 8.74% i.e. only 9 bps increased from 8.65% as on 31st March 2018, whereas industry's cost of borrowing increased by 80 bps during the same period
- During the year 18-19, Aavas raised Rs. 2,144 Cr @ 8.55% against budgeted incremental borrowing cost of 9.21%, thereby saving more than Rs. 5 Cr during the year
- 11 lenders have exposure of more than Rs 200 Cr National Housing Bank, Oriental Bank of Commerce, Indian Bank, Central Bank of India, Axis Bank, IDFC Bank, State Bank of India, HDFC Bank, Andhra Bank, Canara Bank and CDC Group which affirms the credibility and trust established by our team for Aavas in the market



THE EPICENTRE OF POSSIBILITIES:

AAVAS AT KUALA LUMPUR

This April, Kuala Lumpur was witness to two events, that shall significantly impact our goals and endeavours in the new Financial Year 2019-2020.

With the affordable housing segment gaining momentum across the world, the World Bank, in association with Cagamas, hosted a Conference on Constructing and Financing Affordable Housing across Asia, on 2nd and 3rd April 2019 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The objective was to reach the SDG goal of safe, adequate and affordable housing for all by developing innovative solutions, new enabling technologies and means for addressing the challenges faced in meeting the needs of a growing urban population in Asia. The conference was attended by the policy makers working in government looking for new ideas or experiences on how to meet public sector obligations, and private sector lenders, investors or developers who are exploring commercial opportunities in the affordable housing space, from East Asia and Pacific, South Asia and Central Asia, as well as members of the International Secondary Mortgage Market Association.

Aavas Financiers represented by Mr. Sushil Kumar Agarwal, took the opportunity to connect with other industry pioneers. The conference encompassed the following issues:

- 1- Overview of affordable housing challenges and opportunities in Asia
- 2- Islamic housing finance
- 3- Affordable housing financing and delivery country case
- 4- The affordability challenge how to provide safe adequate housing at a reasonable cost?
- 5- Connecting capital markets and affordable housing delivery
- 6- Green and sustainable housing development
- 7- What FinTech can do for affordable housing
- 8- Innovations in financing affordable housing construction
- 9- Community-led housing development viable business models and key lessons learned

The industry experts and leaders addressed the aforementioned issues, ensuing a stimulating session of brainstorming. Mr. Sushil Kumar, introduced Aavas and our journey at the conference. He spoke about our vision for inclusive lending and how we have leveraged upon technology, establishing a network of digital tools and processes. The conference led us to some wonderful insights about the emerging opportunities and practices in the industry. This session explored latest developments in the use of big data to underwrite customers with limited or no credit histories. It also explored possibilities of technology platforms for better delivering credit and look at machine learning/Al as a tool for predicting customer behavior and needs.



On 2nd April, also at Kuala Lumpur, Aavas hosted the Collection Recovery Meet for 14 of the concerned officials, under the leadership of Mr. Sushil Kumar Agrawal and Mr. Surendra Sihag. While learnings were taken from the last FY hits, new goals were set for the upcoming financial year.






