Together with our entire Aavas Family, I look forward to executing our new growth strategy with renewed focus and energy.





Institution-wide User Onboarding and Training Drive

To meet evolving business requirements, improve efficiency and deliver superior customer experience, the Aavas Management team kick-started 'Project Gati on Salesforce Platform' on April-22 with the aim of holistically transforming our Loan Origination journey by leveraging best-in-class technology solutions.

'Gati' Salesforce system Pilot was launched on 23rd January-23 across eight high-performing branches covering 700+ users. Basis the performance of the system during the Pilot Phase, Aavas Leadership decided

to go ahead with the PAN India roll-out of the system starting April-23.

To enable a smooth transition and onboarding of all users on the new system, an institution-wide Gati-Salesforce system Training and Activation drive was launched on March-23.

The support structure of 40 Gati-Salesforce Training Champions was created through the collaboration of the Learning & Development Team, Product & Distribution Team, and SaFE Team. Training Champions were centrally supported by Project Team and 15 Tech/Functional FPRs from the Gati War room for bridging knowledge gaps and resolving any technology-related issues incurred during branch training.

Under the guidance of the senior team and with the tremendous efforts of Training Champions, 320+

Branches were covered through Physical Training sessions in just 20 days. All internal functional users from the Sales, Credit, Legal, Technical, RCU, and Operation teams were trained. User training is done through actual loan application login and live demonstration of End 2 End file processing in the Gati-Salesforce system. The branch level Training effort was further supported by virtual training sessions and Webinars conducted by the Gati War Room team. 2000+ loan applications logged in by users in the Gati Salesforce system

during the training period; credit action initiated on 1300+ files.

The seamless execution of Training and Activation Drive pan India led to the Big-bang launch of the Salesforce LOS solution across 340+ branches and 7500+ users on 3rd April-23.

Post Launch, Salesforce LOS training has been included as part of the employee induction & onboarding program module, where new joinees are acquainted with the new system from Day-1. The team of Training Champions continues to support branches in processing applications in live systems as and when required.

We now have a scalable and integrated LOS Platform to support future business growth and we have become a Digital First, technologically advanced Financial Institution.

Revitalizing Body and Mind Yoga Day Celebration





MSME — The Growth Engine

MSMEs are defined as Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises under the MSMED Act 2006, which falls under the Ministry of MSME. It has been established to facilitate funding, enhance competitiveness,


provide information about development schemes and programs, and establish progressive credit policies.

The MSME sector plays an integral role in the Indian economy, transforming India from a mere market to a global manufacturer by offering a diverse range of products in both domestic and international markets. It has significantly contributed to employment generation and the advancement of the social structure, requiring minimal capital investment through vibrant entrepreneurship. Additionally, it serves as an ancillary industry to large capital-intensive sectors, becoming the backbone of the economy, second only to the Agriculture Sector.

Previously, the classification of MSMEs was based on investments, with a range of 25 lakhs to 10 crores for manufacturing enterprises and 10 lakhs to 5 crores for service enterprises, as per the MSMED Act, 2006, until 30th June 2020.

Adding to the above data, as per the data from Udyam Registrations as of December 31st, 2022, new enterprises enrolled 72% in the Service sector and 28% in the Manufacturing sector. These enterprises were distributed as approximately 96.3% in the Micro category, 3.32% in the Small category, and 0.30% in the Medium category.

According to the Economic Survey, the credit growth in the MSME sector has been remarkably high at over 30.5% during January to November 2022. However, the MSME sector is still facing challenges in accessing capital due to limited knowledge about government schemes. Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) have emerged as a bridge to fill the gaps in capital and credit. As per reports from Financial Express, NBFC portfolios grew by more than 10% (2.32 Lakh crore collateral-free loans till June 2022), whereas bank loans rose by just 5% compared to the previous fiscal year.

As a major and affordable NBFC, we have tremendous opportunities in lending and providing credit to this emerging sector. It is noteworthy that microenterprises in rural areas cover 51% of the total MSME sector. Therefore, we need to identify and segregate rural enterprises where we can provide additional capital requirements. By doing so, we can become a growth promoter in one of the highly vibrant and dynamic sectors of the Indian economy.


